Pictures in the Firelight. Three melodies by WALTER ROLFE, Op. 18; Price, 75 Cents. These three melodies "A Midsummer Wooing", "Interrogation" and "A Lover's Rendezvous", are tender, simple

in theme and strike a responsive chord in the listener's heart.

The composer of this little Suite writes with exceptional charm, each of the three melodies is clothed in agreeable harmonies and the entire set furnishes a delightful recreation for teacher and student. These compositions may be performed by students in the medium grades and the advanced musician will derive much pleasure from them also. Ideal for recital purposes, and for moving picture purposes.

In Minor Mode. Twelve Preludes by REGINALD De KOVEN. Op. 165; Price, 75 cents. As long as Love continues the most imperious passion, and Death the surest fact of our mingled and marvelous humanity, so long will the sweetest and truest music on earth be ever in the minor key.

A Colorado Summer. A cycle of ten pieces by GERRIT SMITH, Op. 21; Price, \$1.25. In beauty, richness and abundance of melody, in all that goes to make a really artistic group of piano pieces, "A Colorado Summer" is distinguished among piano suites by American composers.

From Edgeworth Hills. A suite of four pieces by ARTHUR NEVIN; Price, \$1.25. With such titles as "Panorama," "Sylphs," "As the Moon 'rose," and "Firefly" as subtitles in this suite, it would seem as if poets, painters and composers had exhausted the subjects chosen—but the compositions, by their intrinsic worth and wondrous beauty, prove that such is not the fact.

En Passant. A series of four pieces by ETHELBERT NEVIN, Price, \$1.50. These numbers have all the charm that characterizes the composer's work. In varying moods, one is a spirited number, one abounds in tone color, a third has a graceful, lilting melody, while the concluding number is suggestive of a native negro tune.

O'er Hill and Dale, by ETHELBERT NEVIN, Price, \$1.50. Contents:—"It was a lover and his lass", "The Thrush", "Love is a-straying ever since maying", "The lark is on the wing". The several pieces comprising this delightful suite are as refreshing in their portrayal of nature's moods as are the pages of Hamilton Mabie's enchanting nature essays, "Under Green Trees and Elsewhere". Indeed I can recommend nothing finer than a playing of these charming sketches between chapters of this book. Both breathe so sincerely the breath of nature, that next to being in green fields and under green trees, a perusal of the book and a playing of the music puts one in intimate touch with Dame Nature herself.
