RESPONSE RATES

- Survey was distributed to 159 businesses
- Survey was applicable to 107 businesses
- Survey was responded to by 71 businesses
- 27 of those 71 businesses were pre-revenue
- Survey response rate was 66.3%






METHODOLOGY

- Primary data was collected through surveys conducted online, in person, and over the phone.
- Closed data set December 2015.
- University of Maine economists are running data through an IMPLAN model to calculate the total economic impact (direct impact, indirect impact, and induced impact).
- We are also conducting a separate analysis to look at trends across the aquaculture sector.
- We have already seen some interesting trends in the data before running it through the model.


