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**SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT**

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To Superintending School Committee and citizens of the town of Islesboro I hereby submit my third annual report as Superintendent of Schools.

Those who have been responsible for the educational program of this community have been faced with difficult problems. Teachers are by no means plentiful, operating costs and salaries have increased and many necessary items and repairs have been impossible to obtain.

Since nearby communities and facilities are not readily accessible, Islesboro must assume the full responsibility for offering the best educational and recreational opportunities to the youth of its community. This means we should strive for nothing short of the best in the way of teachers, buildings and necessary materials for carrying on the program.

Our meetings last summer would indicate that some of you were very much concerned with our immediate needs. Eventually we proposed a new single building, to be used for the entire school program. We are asking that a building fund be established and funds raised or donated whenever possible to be accumulated toward the time when it may be possible to go ahead with construction.

In the meantime, we will try to do the best we can with what we have. The heating system at the High School should be improved before another year. We recommend a central heating system, large enough to properly heat the entire building. New lighting fixtures should be installed. Unfortunately we cannot use the first floor of this building to advantage. This makes additional climbing of stairs as well as presenting a problem in heating only the two upper floors. We do however have the advantage of running water in this building.

The Pendleton School eventually should have running water and flush closets as well as a more efficient heating system. We are planning to put up a wire fence along the main highway before another year.

We have been able to offer Hot Lunches again this year and the teachers have generously given their time in preparing and serving the meals. These hot dishes are very much enjoyed and certainly more beneficial than cold lunches which the children otherwise have.

For various reasons we have had too many changes in the High School faculty. This condition has provoked a real hardship especially on the students.

We are anxiously awaiting a new bus which will certainly be appreciated when it finally arrives.

If, in the future, any one of our readers would like a tennis court, well that is easy. You know our library lot extends back to land of F. C. Pendleton, so there is ample room for a good sized court. Several years ago the late Mr. Elwell cleared up a part of this land for this purpose.

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**ANNUAL NURSING REPORT**

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The following is a report of the Public Health Nursing Service submitted for 1946.

The greater part of the Nurse's time was spent in home visiting, so that the parents might have the latest information available on standards of health and hygienic care, in order to maintain good family health.

The nurse made 5 visits to your town during which the following Nursing visits were made:

- 1 to an Expectant Mother
- 5 to Infants
- 10 to Preschool Children
- 1 to School Child

As heretofore crippled children have been kept under supervision through home visits and attendance at Crippled Children's Clinics.

Tuberculin skin testing was done in the schools and an X-ray Clinic was held in July, giving reactors and contacts of active cases of tuberculosis the opportunity to have a chest X-ray.

One of the highlights of the Public Health Nursing Program for the year was the Conference held in Augusta for Lay Committee Members. We hope that next year your town may be represented at such a meeting.

With Community Health Committees organized and participating in the Program, more Child Health Conferences and Immunization Clinics can be held.

Will you help to improve the health of your community?

Art. 7. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of twenty-eight thousand four hundred and forty-nine dollars and twenty-five cents, as suggested by the Selectmen, or what sum of money will the Town vote to raise.

- Art. 12. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$200.00 for the propagation of clams in Islesboro, said sum to be expended under the direction of the department of Sea and Shore Fisheries.
- Art. 13. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,500.00 for the purpose of building a septic tank at the Swimming Pool and repairing present sewer line.
- Art. 14. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$200.00 for athletics in the Islesboro High School.
- Art. 15. To see if the Town will vote to adopt Daylight Saving Time for the summer season of 1947.
- Art. 16. To see what action the Town will vote to take regarding the enforcement of traffic laws in Islesboro for the the summer season.

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- Art. 17. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$15,000.00 for the support of schools for the ensuing year.
- Art. 18. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,000.00 for the repairs of School Buildings.
- Art. 19. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$350.00 for cost of and installation of a 4 foot wire fence across the frontage of the Pendleton School, the same to have wings at each end leading back on school grounds at least 20 feet.
- Art. 20. To see what action the Town will vote to take in regard to a new school building.
- Art. 21. To see what action the Town will vote to take in regard to the construction of certain pieces of town highway.

The Selectmen give notice they will be in session at the Town Hall at nine o'clock in the forenoon on day of said meeting for the purpose of revising the list of voters in the Town of Islesboro. Given under our hands this 16th day of February A. D., 1947.
