Report of Selectmen.

The Annual Report of the Receipts and Expenditures of the town of Poland, for the year ending March 1, 1876, is herewith presented:

After taking an inventory of the Real and Personal Estates, we found the total valuation to be \$448,029.00, and the whole number of polls 500. Basis of valuation fifty per cent.

Agreeable to warrants from the State and County Treasurers, and a certificate from the Town Clerk, we assessed upon the polls and estates the following named sums:

The family on the farm has been unusually large throughout the year. We commenced the year with fifteen paupers, and have that number at the present time. Average number for the year is about sixteen. The persons supported mostly on the farm through the year, are Adaline Cushman, Sophronia Bewley, Melissa Harris, Charles Bonnett, Stanton Estes, wife and four children, Sylvia Brown, Osgood Cole's wife and five children, John Orr, Allen Moody, Hannah Chandler, Joe Tripp, wife and three children. One of Tripp's children died while on the farm. The family being double that of former years, considerable sums had to be expended for bedding, clothing, &c., which otherwise would not have been necessary.

Mr. Schellinger and wife, the overseers of the farm, have been very kind to the family under their charge, all have been clothed and well fed, and good care taken of them generally.

We have paid for supplies for the farm, three hundred sixty-four dollars and ten cents, which includes forty-six dollars paid for the following tools for the farm, *viz.*: 2 plows, 2 yokes and bows, 4 chains, 1 iron bar and 1 pump.

The bridge at Hackett's Mills has been thoroughly repaired, and is in good condition, and will do good service for some time with trifling expense. Chipman bridge

will need some repairs the coming year, and the bridge at the Falls will require considerable repairs if not rebuilt. It being the poorest on the river.

Tripp Pond road will also need an outlay of money, there being much heavy teaming over it, and the highway districts are unable to keep it in repair.

Our pauper bills have been unusually large. The expenses incurred at Lisbon, on account of Nellie Morse, makes the amount paid for paupers not on farm, larger than for some years. Indeed we have had a realizing sense the past year, of what one said anciently: "For ye have the poor always with you."
