Have you signed up for #CampusClear?

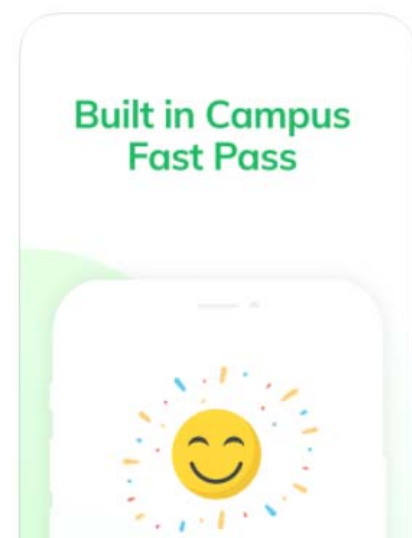
It's the latest effort by the University of Maine System to honor its commitment to fulfill our shared institutional mission this academic year while at the same time limiting transmission of COVID-19.

#CampusClear is a convenient and completely voluntary daily screening app now available to each and every employee allowing for the close monitoring of symptoms you may experience potentially related to COVID-19.

How does it work?

It's a simple daily prompt to indicate any symptoms you may be experiencing that suggest an unusual development in your usual health pattern. Just one of your choices for checking your symptoms, it's a great way to help determine whether attending classes or heading to campus is the best decision for you and for the entire campus community.

Based on your response, you will be provided with input



to make an informed decision about your participation in on-campus activities. It's an educational tool not intended for medical diagnosis and the data collected by the #CampusClear application will only be used by the University to support your own personal health/wellbeing and monitor the potential spread of COVID-19-related symptoms within your specific campus population.

#CampusClear is also not a communication tool and does not alert campus colleagues or managers to your results. It is solely to gain greater awareness of what is happening physically for you at a given time in comparison to symptoms typical of being primary or secondary indications of COVID-19.

Signing up is fast, secure and takes only a few minutes. You always retain complete control over the information you share through the application. Self-screening is also quick and convenient and contributes to safer campus communities for everyone.
