Fogler Library Reopening

Raymond H. Fogler Library will reopen to the University of Maine System on **Monday, August 17, 2020**. At this time, access to the building will be limited to the following:

- Faculty, staff, and students of the University of Maine System
- Staff from the University of Maine Foundation and the University of Maine Alumni Association
- UMaine retirees with a Gold Card

To protect the health of library patrons and staff, we have implemented new procedures for in-person visitors. All **patrons must enter through the Union-facing entrance** and exit through the doors facing the University Mall. Certain sections on the first floor and select stairwells will be limited to one-way traffic. All patrons will need a valid card to access the library.

While building access will be limited to University of Maine System patrons, we are committed to providing the public with continued access to our services and resources. Staff throughout the library are available to provide remote assistance, including staff in [Special Collections](#), [Government Publications](#), [Reference](#), the [Patent and Trademark Resource Center](#), and the [Maine Business, Science and Technology Library](#).

Fogler Library COVID-19 Policies

Entrance and Exit

The only entrance to Fogler Library will be the east entrance facing the Memorial Union. The exit will be the north doors facing the University Mall.

Face Coverings

One-way Traffic on the First Floor

Certain areas on the first floor and select stairwells are open to one-way traffic only. Please look for arrows on the floor and directional signs to help navigate the building.
