Cumberland, Aug. 25.—The Cumberland Farmers' Club Fair opened here today with a good sized crowd in attendance and many racing features. Anna Echo and Pearl Q took straight heat victories in the oat race and the 2.20 trot and pace, while Allie Delmar was forced to four heats to win in the 2.24, which was not finished until late afternoon. Delos M had captured the opening brush.

The second and final day of the fair is due tomorrow when three races, the 2.30, 2.25 and 2.14 are carded. The first two have eight starters while the 2.14 will see seven line up for scoring.

One of the big features of the fair will be the ball game between North Yarmouth and Cumberland. It is a rubber contest, and the feeling between the two teams has become so intense that they have thrown caution to the wind and are battling on a winner-take-all basis. Today's summary:
