A second COVID-19 vaccination clinic, offered in partnership with Penobscot Community Health Center, will be held at [Wells Conference Center](#) at the University of Maine from 1–3 p.m., Wednesday, May 26, offering the one-shot Johnson & Johnson vaccine and the two-shot Moderna vaccine.

No appointment is necessary; community members will choose which vaccine they wish to receive during the registration process at Wells.

For those who received their first Moderna shot 28 days ago at the campus-based clinic on May 26, the second vaccination will be available.

There is no charge for the vaccine. Proof of insurance is not required. If you have an insurance card, please bring it so that any administrative costs will be billed to your insurance company. No one receiving a vaccination will have out-of-pocket costs.
