- The MooseTracks Café and Spirit Shop in Augusta has been renovated and offers an expanded menu, service hours, and UMA-branded apparel. There's even a new espresso machine! All items are available for take-out only and you can order ahead.
- The former UMA Bookstore has been temporarily converted to a spacious student lounge, set up for appropriate physical distancing while relaxing, studying, and eating between classes.
