As indicated in the initial announcement of the UMSpaceSafe application released on August 31st, starting on **Tuesday, September 15th**, all UMaine/UMM faculty, staff, and students working on approved research are **required** to use the [UMSpaceSafe application](#) whenever entering and leaving spaces where their research is conducted.

Usage will be monitored for approved research projects. If it is found that approved project personnel have not been utilizing the UMSpaceSafe app, the project may lose its approval to conduct research.

UMSpaceSafe is accessible using a smartphone or computer with a web browser and your [maine.edu](#) login account.
