## Site for Memorial Building Added to College Land

The act of Warner J. Morse, director of the Maine Agricultural Experiment Station and an alumnus of the University of Vermont, in transferring about 50 acres of the land acquired by him in a recent purchase of the Graves property abutting the University campus on the north, for a figure far below its intrinsic value, is an act of loyalty which has received warmest praise from the parties aware of the transaction.

The figure involved in the deal is \$1300. The purchaser of the land was the University of Maine Memorial Fund Committee. The property was conveyed to the University directly by Dr. Morse in a deed dated July 3, 1923, and recorded in Penobscot Registry, volume 960, page 221.

The Memorial Fund Committee financed the transaction in order that the site for the Memorial gymnasium-armory building recommended by Little and Russell, the University supervising architects, might become University property and therefore available for this purpose.

Not only will this land furnish an excellent site for the Memorial building, but it will provide ample space much needed for the laying out of additional baseball and football fields, and should the need arise, of a new cinder track.

Judge Dunn, as treasurer of the University, upon receipt of the deed to the land penned the following communication to Director Sawyer:

"I am notifying President Strickland of the Trustees, of the generous deed by the Memorial Fund Committee, in causing the conveyance to the Uni-


The Board of Trustees as their meeting July 27 voted that the following resolution be adopted:

"Resolved: That, in behalf of the University of Maine, the trustees accept with thanks the present of the lot of land described as conveyed in the deed of Warner J. Morse to the University, which deed is dated July 3, 1923, and recorded in Penobscot Registry, volume 960, page 221; the consideration for this conveyance being paid for by the Maine Memorial Fund Committee.

"This voluntary transfer of property manifests anew that the affections of the Alumni are intimately intertwined with Alma Mater. S staunch and sincere as their loyalty is, their veneration is not less firmly rooted, and love and affection conspire to attach them to the University's significance and importance."

In appreciation of Dr. Morse's act of generosity the following resolution was adopted:

"Resolved: That, the Trustees of the University of Maine, recognizing the interest in and loyalty to the greater development of the University which Warner J. Morse, Director of the Agricultural Experiment Station, has shown in turning over to the University under most considerate conditions certain land to the north of the present campus, hereby tender to him their sincere thanks for, and appreciation of his attitude in this matter."

"It is a pleasure to me to testify to the splendid support of the present Board of Trustees by the Alumni, and this latest appreciation I know will be particularly gratifying to the members of the Board, in whose behalf, I extend my thanks."

Your editorial staff admits its inability to make figures lie and submits a few figures as facts for home consumption in regard to the Memorial Fund Campaign.

For the sake of being conservative let us assume that only 3,000 or 60% of our alumni subscribe. Approximately 2,000 have already subscribed \$350,000, leaving \$150,000 to be raised by 1,000 alumni—an average of \$150 per subscriber.

A marked tendency has been noted of late for subscribers to confine themselves to the \$100 figure. Over five years that figures 38 cents per week. Raised to \$150, the average needed to assure success, becomes 57 cents per week.

Heinz's 57 varieties brought success to the pickle manufacturer. At least 57 of the smallest exchangeable units of our currency per week from the remaining 1,000 subscribers are needed to bring success to the Memorial Fund Campaign. Even then every alumnus and former student who can afford to must make a subscription far in excess of the \$150 amount.

Moral: If you're thinking in terms of \$100, remember the pickle manufacturer.

## Judge Dunn to be Treasurer Emeritus

The announcement that the fourteen years of continuous service as treasurer rendered the University by Charles J. Dunn '20 (honorary) of Orono, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court of Maine, would shortly terminate was made at the conclusion of the meeting of the Board of Trustees held on the campus July 27. As soon as his successor, Mr. Youngs, qualifies and takes control of the treasurer's office, Judge Dunn will become treasurer emeritus and assume the duties as guardian of the trust funds of the University.

His services were fittingly reviewed in the following resolution:

"Whereas, the Maine Legislature of 1921 passed an Act by which the University of Maine, beginning July 1, 1922, should have the full time services of a treasurer; and

"Whereas, the fulfillment of the purpose of this Act makes necessary the resignation of Associate Justice Charles J. Dunn as Treasurer of the University; be it

"Resolved, that the Trustees of the University of Maine, assembled in executive session, desire to put on record their appreciation of the distinguished services rendered by Mr. Dunn during his term of office.

"Mr. Dunn became treasurer of the University in 1909 and he brought with him a fitness for this task which was strikingly pronounced.

"He has manifested in a remark-

of the Board of Trustees July 27 Frederick S. Youngs '14 of Bangor was elected to fill the position to be automatically vacated shortly by Judge Charles J. Dunn as the result of state legislation, making the treasurership of the University a full-time position.

Mr. Youngs will become the youngest executive officer at the University. He comes well qualified to assume the duties of the position. Although graduating from the University in 1914 with the degree of B. S. in civil engineering, he has devoted his energies since graduation to the accounting and purchasing end of business. He spent five and one-half years with the Great Northern Paper Co. at the Bangor office in cost work in the Division of Forest Engineering. Giving up his position as assistant head of the division in November, 1919, he became assistant head of the Accounting Department of the E. B. Draper Co. In April, 1922, he resigned this position to become treasurer and purchasing agent of the J. F. Philippi Co. of Bangor.

Mr. Youngs is married and has two children, a girl of seven years and a boy of five and one-half years. He will commence his duties at the University about August 15.

able degree a spirit of unselfishness which has caused him on many occasions to serve the University when circumstances would seem to demand that his services should be engaged in other directions.

"He brought to the position a recognized business sense,—a most invaluable asset.

"His profound knowledge of the law and his keen sense of justice have greatly contributed to the solution of problems which have come before the executive officers of the University.

"By no means least, he brought to the University a loyal devotion which has deepened during his years of service. It is a situation somewhat unique in academic circles that an entire family should hold degrees from a single institution, as was the case when on June 5, 1922, his youngest daughter received the degree of Bachelor of Arts. The services of Justice Dunn have, therefore, been rendered, not in a perfunctory manner, but with a personal devotion to the University with which he has been connected.

"In paying this tribute to the work which has been accomplished the members of the Board of Trustees venture to express the hope and confident expectation that when the official relations between themselves and the present Treasurer are terminated, the personal kindly relationships of the past fourteen years will continue to exist.

"With this in mind he is hereby appointed Treasurer emeritus and guardian of the trust funds of the University."

## Deering High Job for Flack

The plum of high school coaching jobs in the state of Maine has fallen to the lot of Howard Flack, until his resignation this June the University track, cross country and basketball coach. September 1 Coach Flack assumes the role of football, basketball and baseball coach at Deering High School, succeeding "Pat" French '17, who is to confine himself to the duties of track coach and teacher at the same school.

Flack's experience is versatile, both in the playing and the coaching of the three sports assigned to him at Deering. His many friends are pleased that he is to remain within the borders of the state. His new position will make it possible for him to continue his effective summer work as an umpire of the local semi-professional baseball games, and during the winter as a basketball official of distinction.


