The Dance program is stronger than ever, as evidenced by the growing numbers of students involved. During the 1994-95 season, there were 194 students enrolled in all classes and all sections of dance classes. In the current academic year, there are 416 – more than double the students! The program has steadily increased each year and now includes 31 dance minors.

Tap will be offered for the first time in many years, intended to coincide with the production of *Chicago*. In addition, a Fosse-style jazz class will be offered.

For the upcoming season, we would like to request funding to support the dance productions. The budget will help in the areas of costume, publicity, programs, lighting, and props. The choreographer and lighting designer fees will be covered by the College of LAS.
