CLOSED EXECUTIVE SESSION
August 10, 1971 at Bangor

Chairman Cutler reported to the Clerk that the following statement was ADOPTED by a vote of eight to five:

The Board of Trustees of the University of Maine has deemed this an appropriate time in the University's history to review with the Chancellor the performance of his administration during these past two and one-half years. The Board has met both collectively and individually with the Chancellor to discuss frankly and honestly the position of the University in its constant efforts to serve the people of Maine.

At this time, the Board wishes to express its confidence in the leadership of Donald McNeil as Chancellor of the University and pledges to work with him and other members of the University community toward an educational institution of greater and greater service to the society which has created it.

There was discussion of the desirability of regular, periodic review of the stewardship of the Chancellor.
