Sat. Sept. 1. 1894.

Pleasant, Clara and Carroll came to Eastport after me and Lizzie came up with us. I got my cow out of Plummer's barn to night.

Sept 2. Sunday.

Pleasant the children went to Sunday School, Sadie, Elias and Will were in here a little while today, Clara and I went over to the other house a little while.

Mon. Sept. 3.

Pleasant, Will and Sarah carried me to Eastport Lizzie went down with them.

Tues. Sept. 4th

Pleasant Clara washed Mr. Smith pulled my beans.

Wed. Sept 5. 1894.

Pleasant very dry and smoky rained a few big drops to night put the roosters in the coop to begin to fat them.

Thursday. Sept. 6.

Pleasant the children and I went out to Grandmother Carter and mother went down to Effie.

Friday Sept 7th

Pleasant, Mother, Bertha and Edna came over to dinner Carroll and Thomas went out to their Grand mother of an errand.

Sat Sept. 8.

Pleasant, Elias went to Eastport after Willis

Sunday, Sept. 9.

Pleasant. Stayed at home all day. Willis and I went over to the other house a little while to night. Clara and Adna Smith came there a little while.

Monday, Sept. 10

Elias carried Willis to Eastport. Florence Ward and Edna was here to supper.

Tuesday, Sept. 11.

I washed Elias and Florence. Went up to Grandma Smith's.

(Fair) Sept. 12 Wednesday.

Pleasant. Father and the boys put our beans in the barn.

(Fair) Thursday, Sept. 13. Day.

The children and I went out to their Grandmother's, she did not go, the Fair. Ellie and a Mr. Crasson came there for a visit from Massachusetts. Willis came from Eastport not very well.

Friday, Sept. 14.

Pleasant. Willis went over to the carner this morning and I went over as far as Charan with him he got the horse shod.

Sat. Sept. 15

Looked very much like rain. Willis went out to his father and stayed till after dinner. He and I went over to the S. A. S. to night. small number present.

Sunday. Sept. 16^{1894.}

Looked like rain this morning Willis and I went over home a little while this afternoon Elias came from Red Beach he had been to carry Florence home.

Monday Sept. 17

Rained very hard this fore noon Willis killed and we picked and dressed 8 chickens Elias and Willis went to Eastport this afternoon, and kept the horse down all night. Mrs. Kronton brought the horse back (Tuesday), 18th Clara and Charles were here Clara worked on my dress.

Wednesday. Sept. 19

Pleasant, today looked like rain to night I have been sick to day with bad pain across me and was sick all night last night.

Thurs.

Wed. Sept. 20, 1894.

A very rainy day I caught a bit of water. Stella stayed home from school Vervie & Thompson arrived home tonight Will Woodworth brought her in.

Friday Sept. 21.

Pleasant to day I washed a large wash Stella stayed home again to day We went over home this afternoon.

Sat. Sept. 22.

Pleasant. Mr. Carter went to Eastport to day and Willis came up with him I did not feel very well today.

Sunday. Sept. 23.

Pleasant. Willis went to Eastport Will. Morgan carried him down to the bridge

Monday, Sept. 24, 1894,

Pleasant. Mother, Venie and I went out to Mrs. Carters. Carroll and I went to the corner to night.

Tues. Sept. 25.

I went over to the other house and stayed to dinner. Venie came over here and stayed to supper. We churned.

Wed. Sept. 26.

Pleasant. I washed. Aunt Rhoda, Etta, Clara Hayens, was here today. Aunt Rhoda, Etta, and Venie stayed to supper, and Venie stayed to supper, all night.

Thursday Sept. 27.

Aunt Vene, Carroll and I went to Penhoke.

Friday, Sept. 28, 1894,

Pleasant. Father carried Venie to Eastport enroute for home today. Aunt Cardine Curtis came in today and stayed here to supper. She and mother, she stayed over home all night.

Sat. Sept. 29.

Pleasant, and very warm. I went to Eastport after Willis, the horse fell down and hurt his knees quite badly. Seddie and Will came up too.

Sunday, Sept. 30.

Pleasant. Willis Seddie, and Will went to Eastport. Father carried them ~~them~~ to the bridge.

Monday, Oct. 1 1894,

Pleasant. Clara Orren came over here and worked on my dress a while mother came over and stayed to dinner brought a cabbage.

Tuesday, Oct. 2nd

Looked like rain did rain some, Mother and I went out to Meda Carters and stayed to dinner I came home and churned, Father finished digging Henry Carters potatoes tonight.

Sat Nov 3.

1894

Looked like a storm this morning. Willis went to Eastport this morning it began to blow unusually hard and rained some this afternoon, just before dark it blew almost a gale. Mother came over and stayed all night. Father down river.

Sunday Nov 4th
Very pleasant Willis to Eastport to day, stayed alone all day with the children, was very lonesome.

Monday, Nov 5th
Monday night, a big snow storm Tuesday morning the ground covered with snow and drifted quite badly the wind blowing very hard. A big tough storm. (Snow storm)

Fri Nov. 9-1894

Thurs. Nov. 8-1894

There being no work in the factory we all came home - walked up. Mrs. Smith was to the Head of the Tide and I rode in with her. Pretty good slighting

Sat Nov. 10-

Snowed and rained about all day.

I worked under the barn.

Mon. Nov. 12-

Elias and I went down to Eastport this morning with Allie Brown - mail stage. Seven in all went down. I made 9 cases - 1.08

Tues. Nov. 13-

Worked all day.

Wed. Nov. 14

No fish.

Worked. Finished for awhile

Friday, Nov. 16-1894-

No fish yesterday and we came up last night. I killed my hog today - Mr. Smith helped me. I went out to father's a little while towards night.

Sat. Nov. 17-

Cloudy. - I went to the Corner and got some meal, etc. - Bought an Ulster - ^{10.00} pants and ^{2.50} Vest of Hobart after paying him ^{2.00} ~~10.00~~ in full of $\frac{1}{2}$ - I paid Wilder ^{1.25} ~~1.00~~ in full of $\frac{1}{2}$. Bought a Horse-Blanket of Will Woodworth.

Sun. Nov. 18-

Pleasant, cool. - Clara, Thomas and I went over to the District to meeting this afternoon, and came home via. the brick yard, calling to Arthur's a few minutes. - Mrs. Smith and Elias went to meeting too. Mr. Smith and H. Rice started for Calais in the boat, yesterday

Mon. Nov. 19-94

Raining and wet this fore-noon

Cleared up cold towards night.

I went out and Arthur and

I helped father kill his bull

I cut up my pork this afternoon.
