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## Historical Note

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The society, "All Maine Women", was founded at the University of Maine in April, 1925 to recognize distinguished leadership, scholarship and service to the University and campus community by outstanding women of the incoming senior class.

It is the highest honorary but non-scholastic society for women. Members are chosen from the three upper classes on the basis of exemplary character and integrity, MAINE spirit, scholarship, leadership, and potential for continued contributions to the University of Maine.

Members of All Maine Women can be distinguished by their special pins, sweaters, and the tiny pine tree they wear on their cheek one day a week and at special functions.

The Living Library Project was a joint project with the University of Maine President's Council of Retired Council.

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## Scope and Contents

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The records contain mostly textual information created the All Maine Women Group, but there is also a USB drive containing interview recordings in both MP3 and Windows Media format. The records include a history of the organization, membership information, correspondence, financial records, and information about special projects and events.

The Living Library Project interviews are with UMaine retirees: Devon Storman, Herald Brown, Nancy MacKnight, and Robert Cobb.

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## Arrangement

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The University of Maine All Maine Women Records are arranged intellectually by the series 1. Member Relations Records, 2. Event & Meeting Records, 3. Financial Records and 4. Biographical & Historical Records. When possible the physical original order of the material was maintained.
