PRESENT: Chairman L. M. Cutler, H. R. Brown, R. N. Haskell, S. T. Hughes,

Dr. Cutler convened the meeting.

Veterans Education. In response to the Board's request in the April meeting for staff study of and recommendations for ways and means to assist returning veterans, the Chancellor and Dr. Freeman outlined a series of actions which could be undertaken within the University's limited resources and Dr. McNeil recommended that the Board formally adopt some policy on veteran education. After discussion, the staff was directed to prepare a general statement for the consideration of the full Board at its meeting on August 10, based on the recommendations contained in the staff report, a copy of which is appended to the file of these minutes.

Protection of right to change tuition and fees. The Chancellor requested Committee reaction to a draft to clarify language used in University publications to indicate the University's right to adjust tuition and fee schedules, as necessary, up to the date of final admission or registration for a given term. It was the consensus of the Committee that decisions on this matter should be exercised by the administration and that no Board action was required.

Continuing Education. In the July meeting the staff was directed to operate Continuing Education and the Summer Session on a break-even basis and Dr. McNeil reviewed the necessary changes that would be required to implement the Board's decision. After discussion and on motion of Mr. Haskell, it was VOTED: that the Executive Committee recommend to the Board that part-time tuition rates be increased to \$25.00/hr.

There was consensus that the initiation of uniform salary scales for Summer Session and Continuing Education faculty and retention of the part-time tuition ceiling could be handled administratively.

The remainder of the session was given over to a discussion of the format for the public meeting scheduled for the following day (August 10) when the Board would meet to hear the reactions of students and other interested persons to the recently approved tuition increases.
