WATER FACILITIES:
 Water works owned by Fort Kent Water Co. Built 1913. Water flows by gravity from Hubbard Brook to a 500,000 gal reservoir located 130 above & about 1/2 mile S of town. Average pressure 40 to 80 lbs. 7 miles of 6" to 10" cast iron w. r. & 2 1/2" fire hydrant pipes located 1/2 mile S.W. of town is equipped with an electrically driven pump, cap'd 600 g.p.m. which pumps from Hubbard Brook directly into system.

FIRE DEPT:
 Volunteer - co of 12 men, chief, first chief & 10 men. Driver lives at Fire Station. 1 Fire Station shown on sheet No. 1. 1 1/2" gal. chemical tank & 400' suction hose in reserve. Fire "blower" & bell in each house. Fire is operated from telephone exchange. No other alarm. No fire limits.
 Grades slightly rolling. Streets unpaved. Public lights etc.
