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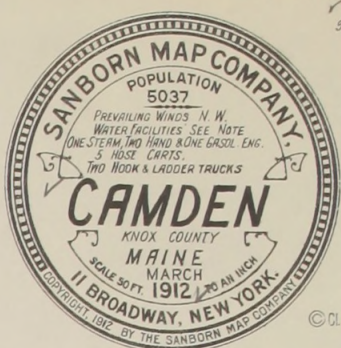

POPULATION - CAMDEN: 3015, ROCKPORT: 2022

WATER FACILITIES:-
Owned by Camden Rockland Water Co. Constructed in 1887. Gravity system supplied from Mirror Lake. Situated about 5 miles N. of Camden P.O. at an elevation of 845' above ground at Camden P.O. 16" x 10' mains to N. Rockport. 12" mains from N. Rockport to Camden & Rockport. Flow into distributing mains the surplus flowing into 450,000 gal. stand pipe, located as shown on key map at an elevation of 330' above ground at Camden P.O.
CAMDEN:-
Average pressure at P.O. 115 lbs. 47' hyd. About 9 1/2 miles of pipes 4" to 10" diameter.
ROCKPORT:-
Average pressure at fire station 30 lbs. At corner of Main & Commercial Sts. 100 lbs. 22' hyd. About 4 miles of 4" to 10" diameter pipes. No information available as to average daily consumption. The same system also supplies the cities of Rockland & Thomaston.
CAMDEN FIRE DEPT:-
Volunteer. 1 chief engineer, 1 assistant, 60 men paid for service. 1 No. 2 steam fire eng. 1 hand eng. 1 H.M.L. truck. 3 hose carts. 3 extinguishers. 3000 lbs. R.L.C. hose in good condition. No F.A. Tel. system. Steam gong at Knox Woolen Mills used for alarm signal.
ROCKPORT FIRE DEPT:-
Has been temporarily disbanded for several months usually consisting of 1 chief engineer, 3 assistants, 40 men and 10 horses. 1 No. 1 steam fire eng. 1 H.M.L. truck. 2 hose carts. 1200' 2 1/2" Rubber lined cotton hose in fair condition. 1200' 2 1/2" Rubber lined cotton hose in poor condition. Steam gong at Rockland Rockport Line Co. power house on Commercial St. used for alarm signal.
Streets lighted by electricity. Not paved.
