The building served as the library for the campus until the 1940s. In the distance stands Balentine Hall, the first official dormitory for females on the UMaine campus which opened in 1914. The dormitory was named for Elizabeth Abbott Balentine, the first female staff member at UMaine. The postcard bears an October 25, 1915, postmark. (See also p06894_back.)
