<p>University students who plan to study or participate in other in-person activities at University of Maine System locations in summer or fall 2022 must receive all recommended COVID-19 vaccines, including any booster dose(s) when eligible, and must provide that documentation to the University System; or must obtain a University System-approved religious or medical exemption. In short, in-person students must be "Up to Date" with COVID-19 vaccinations as defined by the US CDC or have a University System-approved exemption by the start of any semester for which the student will be in person at a University System location.</p> <p>The University of Maine System also requires testing for COVID-19 in many circumstances. All students should monitor their University communication and come prepared to meet all COVID-19-related vaccination, testing or other requirements in place to respond to continually evolving public health needs.</p> <p>More details will be added to this section in the near future.</p>
