Even if you're not interested in any special song or dedication, drop me a card or letter, Bob Day, WLBZ in Bangor, enclose a dime for the March of Dimes and listen, won't you, to the Bob Day Show every Saturday morning from 8:15 until 10 o'clock over WLBZ. That's for the best in country, Western, and hillbilly kind of music
