#### SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

To the Superintending School Committee and Citizens of the Town of Benedicta:

I hereby submit my annual report.

The Benedicta schools under the efficient instruction of Edna MacAvoy and Margaret Qualey are having a successful year. With an enrollment of 37, the primary school has a good record of attendance for the Fall and Winter terms. 17 pupils were not absent a half day, and 22 were not tardy during the Fall term, although there were 46 instances of tardiness. A large percent of the pupils are doing very good work.

The 5th, 6th and 7th grades have an enrollment of 31. There were 105 instances of tardiness during the Fall term and only 6 pupils were not tardy. The record for the Winter term will probably be little better. Five pupils have done exceptionally good work, and 6 others have done very good work.

I found the schools well supplied with books, and few additions have been necessary. I notice that few parents have visited school, and hope that parents will come to realize that their visits would be a great inspiration to both teachers and pupils.

I recommend the following appropriations:
