REPORT OF SCHOOLS

To the Citizens of Burlington:

We hereby submit the annual report of schools for the year ending March, 1939.

During the past year, new blackboards have been bought for the Hill and Corner Schools. Another improvement has been the application of oil to the schoolroom floors.

The Hill School Building needs to have some new inside doors and some repairs made on the supports under the floor. The wall under the building is in a very bad condition and needs repairs. The roof at the Long Ridge School leaks and needs more repairs.

The school attendance has shown some improvement during the past year but there are still some cases of unnecessary absence. Regular attendance at school is necessary if children are to be promoted at the end of the school year.

This year we have been fortunate in being able to secure children's books from the Bangor Public Library so each school in Burlington has started a small school library. If we can add to these libraries each year, the schools will eventually be able to provide the reading background that the children need so much when they begin their English Course in secondary schools.
