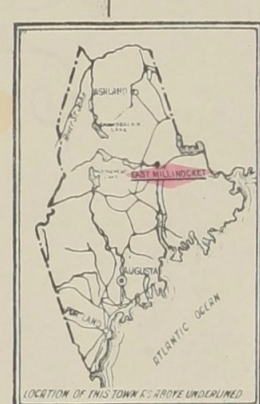

WATER FACILITIES:
 Water Works built 1907, owned by private company. Water pumped to Stand Pipe by 4 pumps from 3 driven wells and also from river. Stand Pipe 250,000 gals. capacity (30' x 50') is located 1/2 mile N.E. of Main St. and 130' above same (top 180'). 7 miles of water mains, 6" x 8" x 10'-32' hydr. Press. on Main St. 45 lbs. per sq. in. average daily consumption 125,000 gals. System is also con'd. to 2 pumps in Great Northern Paper Co's Mill by 10" W. Pipe. 1 Knowles 1500 gal. La France rotary 1000 gal.

FIRE DEPT:
 Volunteer, 27 Men-1 Curbin Hose and Hook and Ladder Truck-2 Horses-1 Hose Cart-2 100' 2 1/2" hose Fire alarm system 4 boxes-burg at Fire Dept. Ho. & Whistle at Paper Mill.
 Streets not paved, grades level. Street lights electric.
