In presenting this annual report of the financial condition and operating procedure of the Town of Burnham we are breaking a long established procedent in supplementing the report with this summary.

All government is faced with the same rising costs which is so apparent to every citizen in his private life. Additional sources or new sources of revenue must be found to meet these rising costs in the long range taxation program.

There is at present no mechanism for obtaining revenue from new sources and until this is provided there is no other way but to add this increasing burden to real estate.

We have had a conference with the State Board of Assessors and the State has requested that there be an increase in the valuation of buildings. Land is valued at present as high as it can be.

This measure was formulated for the purpose of a more equitable distribution of taxation. If the Assessors for 1948 carry out this directive from the State Board of Assessors it is probable that any increase in the tax rate will be small. Otherwise the budget which is recommended and which must be raised together with all overdrafts will result in an appreciable increase in the tax rate. Overdrafts must be taken care of currently or they will result in an increase in debt which we will not be permitted to carry.

There has been no period in our lives when more careful consideration should be given to municipal questions as shown in the warrant, than at present.

We strongly urge that this consideration be given.

Town Warrant

To FRANK CUNNINGHAM, a constable of the Town of Burnham, in the County of Waldo, GREETING:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Burnham, in said County, qualified by law to vote in town affairs, to meet at Burnham Town Hall, in said town on Monday, the 8th day of March A. D. 1948, at ten o'clock in the forenoon, then and there to act on the following articles, namely:

- Art. 1. To choose a moderator to preside at said meeting.
- Art. 2. To choose all necessary town officials for the ensuing year.
- Art. 3. To see if the town will vote to accept the reports as submitted by the several town officers.
- Art. 4. To see if the town will vote to elect a Road Commissioner for the ensuing year, and if so to elect one.
- Art. 5. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for the support of schools for the ensuing year. (Recommended \$11,245.00).
- Art. 6. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for school repair for the ensuing year. (Recommended \$140.00)
- Art. 7. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate to cover the Overdraft in the Village School Building Fund Account. (Recommended \$280.67)
- Art. 8. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for salary for the school board for the ensuing year. (Recommended \$75.00).
- Art. 9. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for town officer's salaries for the ensuing year. (Recommended \$1,000.00).
- Art. 10. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for town charges for the ensuing year. (Recommended \$500.00).

- Art. 11. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for payment of town debt. (Recommended \$1,000.00).
- Art. 12. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for interest for the ensuing year. (Recommended \$700.00).
- Art. 13. To see if the town will vote to allow a discount of 2 per cent on all 1948 taxes paid within ten days from date of commitment, with the exception of poll taxes.
- Art. 14. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for abatement and discount of taxes for the ensuing year. (Recommended \$700.00).
- Art. 15. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate money to repair the Sebasticook River bridge located in Burnham Village. (Recommended \$500.00).
- Art. 16. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for the town highways and bridges for the ensuing year. (Recommended \$2,400.00)
- Art. 17. To see if the town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to contract for snow removal for a period not exceeding five years.
- Art. 18. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for the maintenance of State, State Aid, and Third Class Roads for the ensuing year. (Necessary State and State Aid \$591.30; Third Class \$250.00. Total \$841.30).
- Art. 19. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for snow removal and sanding for the ensuing year. (Recommended \$2,500.00).
- Art. 20. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for the removal of bushes for the ensuing year. (Recommended \$100.00 plus 1947 overdraft of \$397.00; Total Recommendation \$497.00).
- Art. 21. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for State Aid road construction (in addition to the amounts regularly raised for care of ways, highway and bridges) under the provisions of Section 19, of Section 3, Chapter 229, Public Law of 1937, (Recommended \$799.50).

- Art. 22. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for insurance of town property. (Recommended \$175.00).
- Art. 23. To see if the town will raise and appropriate the sum of \$200.00 to cooperate with the Maine Forest Service and Federal Government in control of the White Pine Blister Rust in accordance with Revised Statutes, Chapter 11, Secs. 62-63-64.
- Art. 24. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for care of cemeteries. (Recommended \$75.00 plus \$53.00 to cover 1947 overdraft. Total Recommended \$128.00).
- Art. 25. To see if the town will vote to turn over the appropriation of \$75.00 raised for the care of the town cemetery lots, to the Home and Community Welfare Committee of Sebasticook Grange for the purpose of caring for the town cemetery lots.
- Art. 26. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for the street and other lights for the ensuing year. (Recommended \$300.00).
- Art. 27. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$75.00 for the public health nursing in Burnham, said sum to be expended by the State Bureau of Health for local service.
- Art. 28. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for the support of poor for the ensuing year. (Recommended \$1,000.00 plus \$500.00 to cover 1947 overdraft. Total Recommended \$1,500.00)
- Art. 29. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for its proportion of Mother's Aid (Recommended \$205.00 plus \$430.00 to cover 1947 overdraft. Total Recommended \$635.00).
- Art. 30. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$25.00 to be paid to the State of Maine Publicity Bureau to be expended and used for advertising the natural resources, advantages and attractions of the State of Maine in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 5, Section 82, of the Revised Statutes of Maine.
- Art. 31. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,114.43, to cover the overdraft for fire protection in 1947.

- Art. 32. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$750.00 to be applied towards the purchase of a fire pumper and to authorize the Selectmen to purchase said fire pumper.
- Art. 33. To see what action the town will take in regard to the collection of taxes for the ensuing year.
- Art. 34. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$150.00 to be used for the legal collection of all unpaid taxes, personal and poll, for all years up to and including 1947.
- Art. 35. To see if the town will vote to authorize the Selectmen and Treasurer to make temporary loans in anticipation of taxes and to issue and negotiate notes therefor, or renewals thereof, on any notes in place of the original notes when paid, to the amount which at any time shall not exceed in the aggregate the total tax levy of the preceding municipal year, all such notes to mature and to be paid during the municipal year in which they are issued out of money raised during the current year by taxes, in accordance with the provisions of R. S. Maine 1930, Sec. 83, Chapter 5, as amended.
- Art. 36. To see if the town will vote to authorize the Town Treasurer to execute for and in behalf of the Town a deed releasing the Town's interest in these lots of real esstate in which the town has acquired an interest by enforcement of tax liens when the tax on such lots are paid.
- Art. 37. To see if the town will vote to authorize a majority of the Selectmen to sell at such consideration as they deem advisable all the Town's title and interest, now and hereafter acquired under tax liens and authorize the Town Treasurer to execute for and in behalf of the Town a deed conveying the Town title and interest thereof to the purchaser.
- Art. 38. To see if the town will vote to authorize the school committee to appoint a School Physician.
- Art. 39. To see if the town will vote to authorize the Town Treasurer to withhold up to fifty per cent of any monies which the town owes any taxpayer of Burnham, such fifty per cent to be applied on unpaid taxes due the town by the individual from which such sum is withheld.

- Art. 40. To see if the town will vote to sell the Town Farm and if so, the method to be used in selling same.
- Art. 41. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$500.00 to pay for necessary labor in grading around the Town Hall. Gravel to be furnished without charge to the town by D. M. Susi.
- Art. 42. To see if the town will accept from Inez Mudgett Goodwin the sum of \$200.00 to be held in trust and the income to be used for the upkeep and care of the Franklin Mudgett Cemetery Lot in the Church Yard at Burnham Village.
- Art. 43. To see if the town will vote to build a school-house as outlined by the school building committee.
- Art. 44. To see how much money the town will vote to raise and appropriate towards the building of a new school-house.
- Art. 45. To see if the town will vote to elect a school-house building committee.
- Art. 46. To see what action the town will take with respect to the building of a new schoolhouse.
- Art. 47. To take care of any other town business to come before the meeting.

The Selectmen hereby give notice that they will be in session at the above named Hall and place of meeting on Monday, the day of said meeting, from 9:30 o'clock in the forenoon and until the polls are closed, for the purpose of correcting the list of voters.
