Ladies and Gentlemen:

I submit herewith for your approval my annual report as superintendent of your schools. During the past year we have paid for thirty-six weeks of school. The year 1933-34 forced us to close during the winter months on account of the severity of the winter and prolonged the school well into the summer months. We have had twenty-one weeks on this school year and plans now are to close the year about the middle of June, completing thirty-two weeks. As you know, this is the minimum number of weeks allowed any town by law. Chester



has for the past several years maintained their schools for thirty-six weeks, but due to the present economical condition, this number has been reduced to thirty-two.

To fill the vacancy caused by the resignation of Miss Minnie Runnells at the close of the spring term, Mrs. Vallee Lord was transferred from the lower school to the Church school at the opening of the fall term and Miss Isabel King was engaged to teach the lower school. At the close of the fall term, Miss King resigned and her position was filled by Mrs. June Farrington.

The lack of visitation of the parents is to be regretted. Very seldom do the teachers have the pleasure and opportunity to talk over school matters which concern each parent as well as the pupils. I assure you the teachers would welcome you and receive any constructive criticism which might be offered. No better resolution could be made than to provide opportunity and time for this purpose.

Due to the blocking of the roads we were forced to close one week earlier than we had planned. We would suggest that schools in your town open during the first week in August and have the long vacation during the winter months. We would welcome the opinions of the voters upon this matter. The transportation has been satisfactory and the children have been made as comfortable as could be done with the facilities at hand. With a regulation school bus, it might be better and more economical. I would like to suggest that if the lower and upper schools were moved to the center of the town, it would be possible to do away with one teacher and thus reduce the expenses for your schools.

It is to be lamented that the town is unable to pay the teachers in money. Provisions should be made whereby the teachers, who have paid out good hard money for their education, should receive the same for their services. I would suggest that action be taken at this meeting to provide payment to the teachers.

In closing, I would express my appreciation for the co-operation and support of the people during the past year.
