SUBSCRIPTION POLICY--SUBSCRIPTION FORM

To all those who subscribed to the Maine Statewide Newsletter in 1980, THANK YOU!!! Here is a brief attempt to clarify the subscription policy for the newsletter.

1. Subscriptions are on a calendar year basis. All subscribers need to return the subscription form only once (with or without money) during the 1981 calendar year, at whatever time is convenient, to be considered a subscriber. If you think the newsletter is worthwhile and want to keep getting it, returning the form is the best way to express that.

2. There is no requirement that you pay for the newsletter. Our first concern is that you read it, use it, and become better informed about social change and progressive activities in Maine. It does cost money to print and mail this newsletter and to pay for phone and travel expenses (not to mention a few people's time), however, so the newsletter will not continue if the bills can't be paid. Your contributions will keep it alive.

3. We think \$4/year is a fair price for the newsletter, but we recognize that some people have more money for such things and others have less. Any amount is appreciated. We are very open to newsletter/newspaper exchanges and will be happy to accept barter items in exchange for a subscription as well. Make us an offer. If you subscribed in 1980 but only received some of last year's issues, then feel free to give a smaller donation for a 1981 subscription.

4. If some things are still confusing, please tell us and we'll try to clear it up next month.
