HONORARY DEGREES

Francis A. Brown

Francis A. Brown. Senior partner Brown, Tibbetts, Churchill and Lacasse, Calais, Maine. Mr. Brown was graduated from the University of Maine in 1943 with a B.S. in Chemical Engineering, and from Boston University School of Law in 1950. He served the University as a Trustee of the University of Maine Foundation from 1971 to 1974, and as a Trustee of the University of Maine System from December, 1973 to November, 1986. During his tenure on the System's Board, he held virtually every office in the Board's organization, including the Chairmanship. Mr. Brown has a distinguished record of public service and is the recipient of many honors. Among these are the UM Alumni Association Black Bear Award, the Rotary Paul Harris Fellow Award, the Jefferson Public Service Award, to name only a few.

Stephen E. King

Stephen King, native of Maine, former teacher of English at Hampden Academy, 1970 graduate of the University of Maine, recipient of the Alumni Career Award, and best-selling writer, is deeply committed to the State of Maine and the University of Maine. He has repeatedly helped young Maine writers find publishers and regularly presents readings and lectures at the University, where he was writer-in-residence 1978-79. King, fully at home in the conventions of suspense and horror fiction, has made these forms a vehicle for a serious exploration of human life. *Cujo*, for example, examines class tensions within American society. All of King's works affirm the need for loyalty and love among human beings, in the face of the internal and external monsters that confront us. At one point in 1980, King became the only American writer ever to have 3 different books—*Firestarter*, *The Dead Zone*, and *The Shining*—on the best-seller list at the same time. King's sixteen novels and three collections of short stories have won him an enormous readership in this country and abroad, bringing worldwide recognition to this University and the State.

Tabitha Spruce King

Tabitha King, internationally published writer, has her roots in Maine. Born in Old Town, graduate of John Bapst High School in Bangor, 1971 graduate of the University of Maine with a degree in history, King speaks of Maine as a haven to artists and writers. King, author of short stories as well as three major novels, has as one of the hallmarks of her developing style and subject matter, the willingness to imagine pain. In addition, King's characters are entirely recognizable. She is a writer of gifts and of labor. King's contributions on the national scale include being a judge for mystery novel awards and working on a television project in celebration of Sherlock Holmes. Her contributions to the University of Maine include being a Lloyd E. Elliott Distinguished Visiting Professor in the English Department, fall 1986. King talks about herself as a Maine person, from a working class town, who "blundered into a career." Her career, her accomplishments, her personal visions have brought recognition to this State and this University and serve as a model for others.

Albert D. Nutting

Albert Nutting, native of Maine, Director Emeritus of the School of Forest Resources, and Fellow of the Society of American Foresters, has had a long and distinguished career in forestry research. A 1927 graduate of the University of Maine with a Bachelor's degree in forestry, Professor Nutting's service to the State of Maine and to the University of Maine has included four years as an Extension Service Forester, ten years as State Commissioner of Forestry, and thirteen years as Director of the University of Maine's School of Forest Resources. It was through his efforts that the funding was obtained to build Nutting Hall, the building that houses the University of Maine's College of Forest Resources. On the national scale, Professor Nutting's behind-the-scenes efforts were instrumental in the passage in 1962 of the McIntire-Stennis Forestry Research Act, which promotes forestry research and graduate education. Professor Albert Nutting, retired since 1971, continues to serve the University and the State on a variety of advisory committees.

UNIVERSITY OF MAINE DEGREES

The University of Maine offers curricula in a wide variety of academic fields leading to the associate, baccalaureate, master's and doctoral degrees. The associate degree is awarded upon satisfactory completion of a prescribed two-year program. Baccalaureate, or bachelor's degree, is awarded to undergraduate students who complete the required program in their respective departments. A Fifth-Year Certificate in Pulp and Paper Management is awarded after a year's specialized study, either concurrently with the appropriate baccalaureate degree, or, separately, a year later. A Certificate of Advanced Study (C.A.S.) is available for specified graduate study beyond the master's degree. Master's and doctoral degrees are awarded to students who complete prescribed graduate study.

Associate degrees are conferred with *distinction*, *high distinction*, or *highest distinction* upon students who have achieved an average rank of B or better as their average grade and is based on all the degree credit taken at the University of Maine. These honors comprise at least half of the degree hours including the last semester of the second year in resident study at the University of Maine.

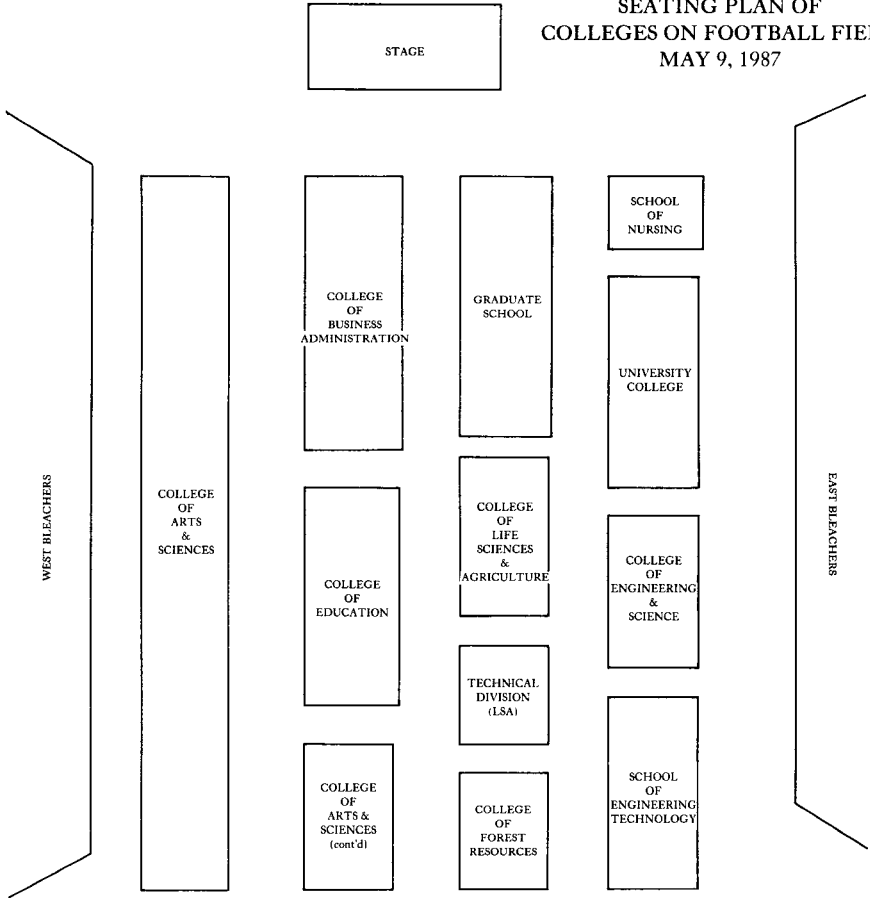
Baccalaureate degrees are conferred with *distinction*, *high distinction*, or *highest distinction* based upon students who have achieved an average rank of B or better and are based on all the degree hours taken at the University of Maine. These hours comprise at least half of the degree hours including the second semester of the senior year in resident study at the University of Maine.

Baccalaureate degrees are conferred with *honors*, *high honors*, or *highest honors* upon students in the Honors Program. In order to receive a degree with honors a student must have a minimum of four semesters of work in the Honors Program, including both semesters of the senior year, and at least one semester of group tutorials.

Degrees are awarded at the end of the semester or session in which degree requirements have been completed not necessarily accompanied by commencement ceremonies. Descriptions of degrees awarded by the University, as well as the requirements for graduation with *distinction* or with *honors* may be found in the general catalog.

The Eastern white pine is the state tree of Maine, and the seedling that each member of the graduating class will receive today, will be a living symbol of the years students have spent at the University of Maine. These seedlings are grown locally by the Maine Forest Service and are distributed today by the students of the College of Forest Resources.

ACADEMIC DRESS

Academic costume originated in Europe about seven hundred years ago. It consists of the gown, hood, and cap. Now much modified, each level of academic achievement still retains a distinctive gown and hood.

The hood, when worn for the bachelor's degree, is three feet long; for the master's degree, three and one-half feet, and for the doctor's degree, four feet. Hoods are lined with the official color of the college or university conferring the degree. For the University of Maine, this is pale blue.

The velvet edging of the hoods varies in width according to the degree. Its color is distinctive of the subject to which the degree pertains. Some of the colors and associated subjects are:

Agriculture	Maize
Arts, Letters, Humanities	White
Business	Drab
Education	Light Blue
Engineering	Orange
Forestry	Russet
Human Development	Maroon
Music	Pink
Philosophy	Dark Blue
Science	Golden Yellow

The caps are usually of the same material as the gown. The tassel is black or the color appropriate to the subject, except that the doctor's cap may have a gold tassel.

Many European institutions have gowns, hoods, and caps or original and frequently colorful design.

Honors graduates are wearing a gold braid cord around their necks.

If Commencement Exercises are held in the Alford Arena, due to inclement weather, the following colleges will be represented at the 10:30 a.m. exercises: Engineering and Science, Forest Resources, Graduate School, Life Sciences and Agriculture, School of Engineering Technology, School of Nursing, Technical Division of I.S.A, and University College. The following colleges will be represented at the 2:00 p.m. exercises: Arts and Sciences, Business Administration, and Education.

Because it is necessary to prepare this program in anticipation of an outdoor commencement, there may be some unavoidable departures should it be necessary to hold two different ceremonies indoors.

The listing of degree candidates as well as the distinctions are tentative only since the printing of this program was required prior to the final certification of each candidate for a degree.
