THE DAILY DOUBLE

The Daily Double Pay is on the first and third races but all tickets for the Double must be purchased prior to the running of the first race. The probable pay-offs on the Double will be announced and posted before the running of the third race. Keep your tickets on the Double until the official winning combination has been announced.
