ad hoc committee - Collective Bargaining

PRESENT: Chairman Kenneth H. Ramage, Francis A. Brown, Jean Sampson and Carlton D. Reed, Jr. Staff: Stanley L. Freeman, Jr., Herbert L. Fowle, Jr., Mary Ann Haas and Sally V. Holm.

Mr. Ramage opened the meeting. The minutes of January 28, 1975 were approved as circulated.

The Committee reviewed Legislative Document 827, An Act Extending Collective Bargaining Rights to University of Maine Employees. There was a brief discussion of a bill to extend collective bargaining rights to employees of the University of Maine under the Municipal Employees Act.

There was general agreement that the Committee would recommend to the Board that the University support LD 827 in the form in which it was submitted, but should it be amended to strike out University-wide bargaining units, the University would withdraw its support.

It was decided that Mr. Brown and Mr. Fowle would speak at the April 1 hearing before the Labor Committee of the Legislature. Mr. Winters and Mr. Frinsko will also attend.
