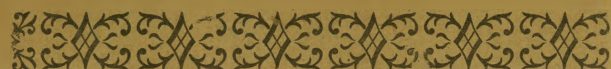

Rule 35—There shall be no refunds on any horse that parades except in cases where a horse that parades is afterwards prevented from starting by reason of sickness or accident or by some other cause which in the opinion of the Judges and the Racing Commission or
