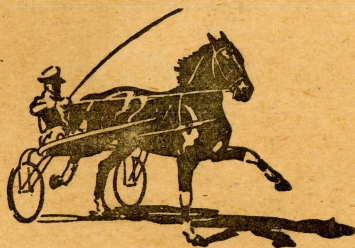

THE DAILY DOUBLE

Windows Open at 12.30

The Daily Double play is on the first and second races, but all tickets for the Double must be purchased prior to the running of the first race. Keep your tickets on the Double until the official winning combination has been announced.

Maine State Racing Rules 35, 94 and 95 have been changed to read as follows:

Rule 35—There shall be no refunds on any horse that parades except in cases where a horse that parades is afterwards prevented from starting by reason of sickness or accident or by some other cause which in the opinion of the Judges and the Racing Commission or their Representative, is sufficient to justify a refund. No refunds shall be made on any horse that parades and which is left at the post.

Rule 94—When a horse in the first race is excused by the Judges before or after parading under the provisions of Rule No. 35, then all money paid for daily double tickets on said excused horse and any horse in the second race of the daily double, so coupled, shall be refunded.

Rule 95—When a horse in the second race of the daily double is excused by the Judges before or after parading under the provisions of Rule No. 35, all money paid for daily double tickets in which said excused horse is paired with the winning horse in the first race shall be refunded.
