PRESENT: Chairman Francis A. Brown, Susan R. Kominsky and James H. Page. Staff: William Wilson.

Chairman Brown opened the meeting and announced that President Neville had said that the Orono campus plans to name the Student Health Facility the Lawrence M. Cutler Student Health Service Building.

Discussion centered around having a scientific program in the afternoon as a start of continuing education for the medical profession. Dr. Wilson said he was sure that three top flight people could be secured for this at a cost of about \$250 each.

There was agreement that no state funds should be used for the dinner that evening. Mr. Page suggested asking each person who wished to attend to pay \$20. The meal cost would be five or six dollars with the rest of the money to go towards a scholarship fund.

The Committee agreed to ask Judge Sidney W. Wernick to be the dinner speaker and Ms. Jean Sampson to be master of ceremonies.

Among those listed as potential dinner guests were: Trustees, former Trustees, the Governor, Chairman of the State Board of Education, leaders of the state medical societies, former Governors, Legislative leaders and the Chief of Staff of EMMC.

There was general agreement that Mr. Brown should contact Dr. Neville for a date when the campus facility would be available for the dinner. The suggested date was May 24, 1975.
