

No refunds shall be made on any horse that parades and which is left at the post. Rule 94—When a horse in the first race is excused by the Judges before or after parading under the provisions of Rule No. 35, then all money paid for daily double tickets on said excused horse and any horse in the second race of the daily double, so coupled shall be re funded.
