<b>Abstract:</b>	This research was undertaken in the mid-1970s to provide supporting data for use as a part of the land claims suit by the Passamaquoddy and Penobscot Tribes. The suit has long been settled and the tribes were federally recognized. Both tribes had been recognized and dealt with continuously since at least the 1700s first by the Massachusetts colony, then by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts as a state and then the State of Maine when it separated from Massachusetts in 1820. This research focused entirely on financial relations. The purpose was to establish that there was a long and continuous financial relationship with the State of Maine and the show the purposes and monetary amounts involved.

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## Biographical Note

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Born in New York City on April 29, 1942, Tony Kaliss was raised in Bar Harbor, Maine and attended public schools there. He attended the University of Chicago, and the University of Maine, receiving a B.A. in United States History in 1969. Continuing his studies at the University of Maine, Kaliss received a M.A. in Economics in 1977. Since finishing his master's degree, Tony Kaliss continued to work on issues between Native and non-Native peoples in the United States, work he had been involved with since first working for the State of Maine's Department of Indian Affairs in 1965. That work took him to various locations, ending with a teaching appointment at the Iliasgvik Tribal College in Barrow, Alaska from 2002-2007 when he then retired. In retirement he continued with his interest in international indigenous issues, eventually completing a Doctorate in American Studies from the University of Hawaii comparing Soviet/Russian and American government policies toward Native peoples on both sides of the Bering Strait. As part of his research he spent a year in Far Northeastern Russia (Chukotka Peninsula) and time in North and Northwestern Alaska.

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## Scope and Contents

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Research material used to compile a listing of financial transactions involving the State of Maine and the Passamaquoddy and Penobscot Tribes from 1759- 2013. Sources included Accounts of the State, Council Journal 1820-1918, Council Register 1821-1840, and Laws, Resolves, Private & Special Acts of the State of Maine, Public Documents of the States of Maine, Records of Warrants and trust fund records and ledgers.
