INTRODUCTORY.

*To the Worshipful Master, Officers and Brethren of
Lygonia Lodge:*

In preparing the following history in accordance with the vote of the Lodge, the writer has labored under many difficulties. It seemed desirable, so far as was possible, to give at the close of the history proper, a brief history, in a tabulated form, of all the members of the Lodge from the date of its institution in 1822, down to the close of 1889. As this period covers about sixty-eight years, it has been found in some cases impossible to state all the facts pertaining to each member.

I have endeavored to give a *history* of the Lodge between certain dates and to omit everything irrelevant to such history. In short, I have endeavored to state in a concise form just what the brethren would wish to know and to omit everything else. It gives me pleasure to acknowledge the great aid rendered me by the efficient Secretary of the Lodge, Bro. James E. Parsons, in preparing this history.

Hoping, brethren, that due allowance will be made for all errors, it gives me great pleasure to submit the following annals of our beloved Lodge.

History of Lygonia Lodge.

A History of Lygonia Lodge, No. 40, Free and Accepted Masons, to extend from the beginning of 1874 to the close of 1889, has been ordered by the Lodge, and the writer, with the aid of James E. Parsons, Esq., Secretary, has been authorized and instructed to prepare it. Lygonia's history previous to 1874, was written, and well written, by the late Joseph A. Deane, Past Master, and carefully revised by Past Master John B. Redman. With those early annals, replete with interesting events, the writer has nothing to do. His task is simply to bring the history from where it was left by other writers, up to the first day of January, 1890.

Lygonia Lodge, during the entire period of its existence, has been a most successful organization. Its growth has been steady, its management wise and healthful, its aim high and steadfast. During its existence of nearly three score and ten years it has seen many changes. Members have come upon the stage of action, acted well their part for years and then have calmly laid down their lives to join the Celestial Lodge above; but Lygonia Lodge might well say, as Tennyson sang of "The Brook:"

"Men may come and men may go,
But I go on forever."

Historical Sketches of Masters and Prominent Members.

NATHANIEL J. MOOR, P. M.

Nathaniel J. Moor, the twenty-fourth and thirty-first Master, was born in Ellsworth, June 30, 1844. He was raised in this Lodge April 22, 1868, and served two years as Master, viz.: in 1874 and 1889. He has filled many places of importance in the Lodge, doing good service in all of them. He became a member of Acadia Royal Arch Chapter in May, 1869, and was High Priest therein for two years.

CHARLES H. JOY, P. M.

Charles H. Joy, the twenty-fifth Master, was born at Surry, Maine, Sept. 18, 1847, and lived in that town until 1878, when he moved to Ellsworth with his father, Charles Joy. He was educated in the common schools of Surry. Together with Samuel J. Morrison, under the firm name of Morrison & Joy, he set up a hard-ware store in Ellsworth, and continued in that business until the time of his death, Dec. 9, 1877. He was elected J. W. in 1871, '72 and '73, S. W. in 1874, and Master in 1875. The *Ellsworth American* of December 13, 1877, in referring to his death, says:

"Mr. Joy had been in business in this city for several years, and had gained a high character for ability and integrity. His sickness was long and painful, but he bore it with wonderful courage, hoping to the last. He leaves a wife and one child."

JOHN B. REDMAN, P. M.

John B. Redman, the twenty-sixth Master of Lygonia Lodge, was elected J. W. at the annual meeting in 1874, S. W. in 1875, W. M. in 1876, 1877, and 1878. He was appointed D. D. G. M. in 1879, and elected S. G. W. of the Grand Lodge in 1883. He was twice elected High Priest of Acadia R. A. C. of which he is a member, and is a member of St. John's Commandery Knights Templar of Bangor. He has served the lodge in nearly all the stations, and has performed the Masonic funeral service probably more times than any one else in Eastern Maine, and is regarded as authority on Masonic jurisprudence. Bro. Redman has held many important positions of trust and honor and is still a young man. He was elected Mayor of Ellsworth in 1884, and re-elected in 1885; served as Judge of the Ellsworth Municipal Court for four years; was appointed by President Cleveland Collector of Internal Revenue for the State of Maine, which position he held until the consolidation of the districts. In 1884 he received the nomination of the Democratic party as candidate for Governor.

WILLIAM H. GRAFFAM, P. M.

William H. Graffam, the twenty-third and twenty-seventh Master, was born at Newport, Maine, in 1839. He was initiated in this Lodge, July 14, 1865; raised Aug. 30, 1865. He was elected Master January 6, 1869, January 1, 1879, January 7, 1880, and January 5, 1881. He made the Masonic work and lectures a study and was well versed therein. He now resides at St. John, N. B.

JAMES E. PARSONS, P. M.

James E. Parsons, the twenty-eighth Master, was born at Providence, R. I., Nov. 17, 1846. He moved to Ellsworth when a boy, living there sixteen years. He enlisted in the Union army in 1863, when seventeen years of age, serving until the close of the war. He came to Ellsworth in 1874. Was initiated in Lygonia Lodge, March 12, 1879, and raised March 26, same year. He was elected J. D. in 1880, S. W. in 1881, and was three times elected W. M., viz.: in 1882-83-84. He was elected Secretary in 1887, which position he still occupies. He became a member of Acadia R. A. Chapter February 3, 1880. He was D. D. G. M. for this District in 1887.

ELMER E. ROWE, P. M.

Elmer E. Rowe, the twenty-ninth Master, was born in Dover, Maine, Dec. 21, 1850. He came to Ellsworth in 1873, and was made a Mason the same year, having been raised Oct. 18th. He was elected S. D. in 1879, '80 and '81, and Master in 1885 and 1886. He was well versed in Masonry, devoting much of his spare time to a study of its principles.

JOSIAH H. HIGGINS, P. M.

Josiah H. Higgins, the thirtieth Master, was born in Eden, Maine, April 15, 1830. He was raised to a Master Mason, in this Lodge, Feb. 24, 1865. He was twice elected Master of this Lodge, viz.: in 1887 and 1888. He served for several years as Secretary and has filled many other positions in the Lodge, to all of which he brought ability and efficiency. He was exalted to the Royal Arch degree in Acadia Royal Arch Chapter, January 19, 1883.

JOHN L. MOOR, P. M.*

John L. Moor has been a member of the Lodge in good standing ever since January, 1827, he taking his first three degrees during that month. He is the oldest Mason and the oldest Past Master of Lygonia Lodge now living. He was appointed District Deputy Grand Master by the Grand Lodge for the years 1851 and 1852, and is now the oldest District Deputy Grand Master for this Masonic District. He was elected J. D. in 1828, J. W. in 1829, S. W. in 1830 and 1831, and Master, September 19, 1832. He was born in Surry, (now Ellsworth) Dec. 1, 1802. By trade he is a house-carpenter, a vocation to which he devoted many years of his life. He has also engaged to some extent in the lumbering business. A man of rare intelligence and excellent business ability, he has held many offices of trust, to which he was called by his fellow-citizens in the course of his long life. For many years he was one of the selectmen of the town of Ellsworth and held many other important municipal offices, both under town and city rule. He was a member of the Legislature in 1837 and again in 1838, when an extra session was called to deliberate on the exigencies which grew out of the disputed Aroostook boundary line. He was also a member in 1856 and 1857. In all the important positions which he has held, whether state or municipal—and he has been called upon to transact important business for both—he brought to them marked ability, integrity and fidelity, and so efficiently and acceptably discharged the important duties committed to his care. Mr. Moor is greatly interested in the local history of the place and being a ready writer he has prepared many interesting and valuable historical articles for the *American* and other papers. These were published over the signature of

"J. L. M.," receiving much favor and many compliments from the readers of the *American*. The most of these articles are to-day preserved in the State libraries of Maine and Massachusetts.

*NOTE.—He was living at the close of the period which this history covers, but died August 20, 1890.

MATHEW H. WOODWARD.

Mathew H. Woodward, one of the oldest living members of the Lodge, was born in Sutton, Hillsborough County, New Hampshire, March 25, 1804. He was made a Mason, September 19, 1828, and has now been a member of the Lodge more than sixty years. Bro. Woodward has served in nearly every capacity, except that of Master, which he declined to accept. Together with Bros. John L. Moor, William Somerby and E. L. M. Allen, he was instrumental in reorganizing the Lodge in 1847. For many years he was a ship-builder and has led a very active life.

CHARLES JOY.

Charles Joy, one of the oldest members of the Lodge, was born in Surry, Nov. 17, 1811. His father was Samuel Joy, whose family consisted of five sons and three daughters. Charles was the fourth son, and he and one sister are the only surviving members of the family. Mr. Joy is a blacksmith by trade. In 1878 he moved to Ellsworth, where he now resides. For many years he owned largely in shipping. In 1857 he was a member of the Maine Legislature, and he has held many places of trust.

NECROLOGY.

BENJAMIN F. THOMAS, P. M.

Benjamin F. Thomas, the sixteenth Master, died at Ellsworth, March 3, 1876. He was J. W. in 1854, S. W. in 1855, and Master in 1856, 1857, 1859 and 1860. He was greatly interested in Masonry and served the Lodge in almost every capacity. He died from paralysis at the age of 53 years.

JOSEPH THOMAS, P. M.

Capt. Joseph Thomas, the eighteenth Master of the Lodge, was lost at sea in 1875 or 1876, exact date unknown. He sailed from a West India port for some port in the United States and was never heard of afterward. It is supposed that his vessel went down in a hurricane and that he and his entire crew were lost. He was S. W. in 1861, and Master in 1862 and 1863.

REV. ABNER S. TOWNSEND.

Rev. Abner S. Townsend was born in the town of Calais, in July, 1833, being one of a family of six children. When nine years of age his father removed to the town of Alexander, and upon a large farm established his home. In the schools of Calais, Alexander and in the academy at North Yarmouth, young Townsend secured a good education. He was the grandchild of Abner Sawyer, a promi-

nent business man of Calais, who at his death left him a large portion of his property. Young Townsend soon engaged in business for himself. When about thirty years of age he became interested in the subject of religion and was converted while attending a series of meetings which were being held in the town of Alexander, and soon after he and his wife became members of that church. Soon after his conversion he was called to the ministry. He joined the East Maine Conference. His first appointment was Lubec, and he afterwards had appointments in Eastport, Dexter, Milltown, Damariscotta, Brewer, Hampden, and Ellsworth, where death closed his labors on the 27th of February, 1885. He was twice married, his last wife and three small children surviving him. Bro. Townsend was admitted to Lygonia Lodge, Sept. 5, 1883, and was its Chaplain at the time of his death.

NATHANIEL MOOR, P. M.

Nathaniel Moor, the eleventh Master, was born at Ellsworth in 1805. He was initiated in Lygonia Lodge, July 22, 1828, and was raised July 30th of the same year. He was elected Master in 1850 and 1853. At the time of his active Masonic service he was considered one of the best informed members of the Lodge. He died at Ellsworth, May 22, 1885.

WILLIAM SOMERBY, P. M.

Brother Somerby died at his residence in Ellsworth, Sept. 28, 1885, at the age of nearly eighty-three years. For many years he had been a prominent Mason and a good citizen. During his early residence in Ellsworth, Judge Somerby engaged actively in business, his vocation being that of tailor. Afterward, for several years, he was

a Justice of the Peace, and later a Trial Justice, in which capacity he performed similar duties to those now performed by the Judge of the Municipal Court. He was buried with Masonic honors. A biographical sketch of Bro. Somerby was published in a previous history of this Lodge.

KILBURN H. SWETT, M. D.

Dr. K. H. Swett died in Ellsworth, May 3, 1886. The *Ellsworth American* in its issue of May 6, 1886, alluding to his death, said:

Dr. Swett was born and reared in Surry. As a young man he was possessed of a most laudable ambition and he early set about the work of earning an honorable position in the world—never for a moment losing sight of the fact that there can be no real manhood, except that which is built on the sure foundation of uncompromising integrity and correct habits. He studied medicine with Dr. R. L. Grindle of Mt. Desert, and took a medical course at Bellevue. He commenced the successful practice of medicine in this city about twelve years ago. As a physician he stood high in his profession; as a citizen he had the confidence and esteem of all, and by all his death is most sincerely mourned. In his intercourse with others he was characterized for ingenuousness of speech and manners. He had but *one* face, and that was an honest, manly one. Duplicity was a word which he did not well understand and a vice he never practiced. People as they meet each other, stop to say: "We have met with a great loss in the death of Dr. Swett!" On the organization of the Hancock Medical Association in this city March 15th last, he was elected President. He was a prominent member of Lygonia Lodge of Masons, also of the Royal Arcanum and other secret organizations in this city. Dying in the very prime and promise of life, at the age of about 35 years, he leaves behind him a widow and four children who have the sympathy of all who know them, in their great sorrow and bereavement.

CALVIN G. PECK.

Calvin G. Peck, a prominent member of the Lodge and an honored citizen, was born in Ellsworth, in 1817. His father, Dr. Calvin Peck, was an active Mason, and was the fifth Master of the Lodge. Calvin G. Peck was the second

Mayor of Ellsworth, having been elected to that position in 1871, and again in 1872. He was Collector and Treasurer from 1878 to 1883, inclusive, and filled several other places of public trust. He died very suddenly of heart-disease, at his residence in this city, Sept. 16, 1886, aged 68 years and 10 months. At his funeral, the Rev. Dr. Tenney, who officiated, said: "I have been acquainted with Mr. Peck for these fifty years. I have known him as a boy, a young man, and a man mature, and I hardly know one, who in all the relations of man to man, has lived a truer life than he has."

HAMILTON JOY.

Hamilton Joy was born in Ellsworth, in November, 1816, and was the oldest of a family of ten or eleven children, seven of whom were sons. He was reared in Ellsworth and lived there all his life, with the exception of a few years which he spent in Boston employed in a chain factory. He was twice married. His first wife, the mother of his children, was the daughter of the late Walter Jordan, whose residence was on the Surry road. His second wife was the widow of Dr. Deming, who was a practicing physician on Mt. Desert Island. He was postmaster under Buchanan. He served the county in the capacity of county commissioner and the municipality in many places of public trust, filling at the time of his death, the office of city treasurer. He was nominated by Erastus Redman, collector of customs, District of Frenchman's Bay, for deputy collector and inspector, but failed to receive an appointment for the reason that his age exceeded the limit prescribed in Department regulations. He was a member of Neal Dow Lodge of Good Templars. He was buried with Masonic honors by the members of the

Lodge in which he was an honored member. He was raised to a Master Mason in Lygonia Lodge, November 28, 1872, and served the Lodge in several capacities. He died December 24, 1886.

JAMES W. DAVIS.

Bro. James W. Davis was born in Ellsworth, February 22, 1820, and for several years acceptably filled the office of Register of Deeds. On retiring from office he engaged in the carriage manufactory, which he pursued successfully and built up a large and prosperous business. He was the originator of the famous Davis buckboard. After many years in the business he sold out to his sons, W. H. and H. E. Davis, and retired to private life. At the time of his death (May 10, 1889, from a stroke of lightning), he was attending to some work on his farm in Surry; as he had left home in the morning in vigorous health, his death cast a gloom over the entire community. Mr. Davis was a man of very decided convictions. Ellsworth's citizens testified to their appreciation of him, by closing their places of business during the funeral services, and by filling the church, where the services were held, to its utmost capacity with sympathizing friends. Though long past the prime of life, Bro. Davis retained his mental and physical vigor to a remarkable degree. He was raised to a Master Mason in this Lodge, January 30, 1856.

CAPT. CHARLES E. LORD.

Capt. Charles E. Lord was born at Surry, August 24, 1830, and was the son of Capt. Melatiah Lord. At the age of sixteen years he commenced going to sea and continued in that calling nearly all the time during the remainder of his life. He became in a short time a very

successful ship-master, who, for his nautical skill, business acumen, strict integrity and unsullied life, had the respect and confidence of all who knew him. At the time of his death he was in command of the bark "Gem" of Boston, owned by John S. Emery & Co. Capt. Lord was a kind man, whether on shore or at sea. Though a strict disciplinarian on board his vessel, his "salt water face" was one full of kindness and justice and consideration. When Capt. Lord arrived in New York a few days before his death, he was not feeling very well, and on June 7, 1889, though able to be about the deck, he complained of pains in the region of the heart, and told the mate who remained by the vessel, that he had better go for a doctor. The mate went at once, but on his return with a physician, a short time after, Capt. Lord was dead. The remains reached Ellsworth on the Saturday evening following, and the funeral was held at his late residence on Pine street on Sunday afternoon. The body was buried with Masonic honors, in Woodbine cemetery. Bro. Lord was raised to a Master Mason, April 24, 1861, and was elected Junior Warden of the Lodge, September 7, 1864.
