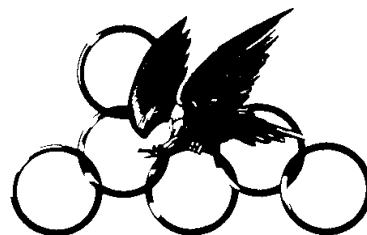

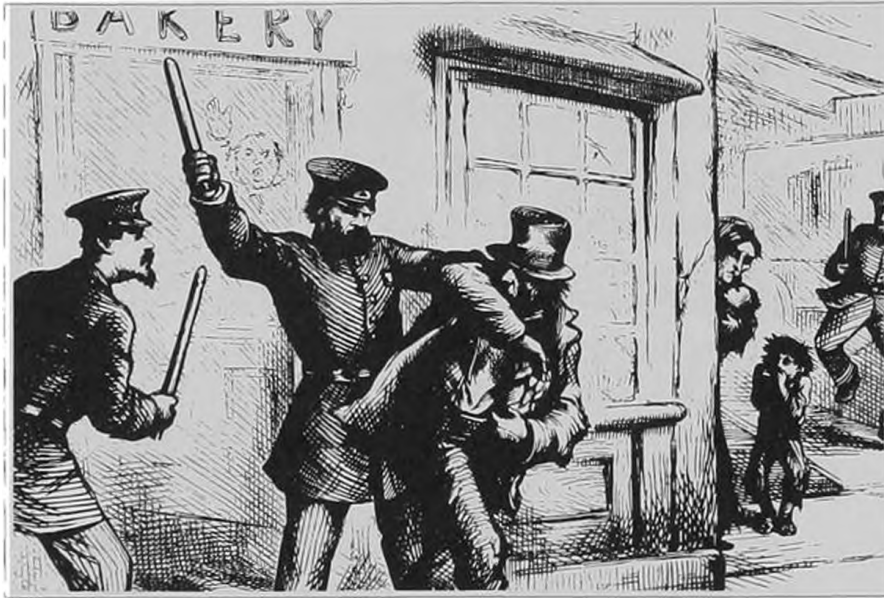

*"A fanatic is a man that does what he thinks the Lord wud do if only he knew th' facts iv th' case," said Mr. Dooley.*

Maine in the 1850s was full of men who fit that description. Neal Dow wanted to separate the lower classes from their rum. Itinerant street preachers railed against the "Whore of Babylon." Ned Buntline referred to the government in Augusta as "stinking and shining like rotten mackerel by moonlight." Know Nothing mobs burned Catholic churches and thousands in Bangor marched to the glare of torches and flaming tar barrels to intimidate Irish Democrats and elect Republican candidates. In **hard times, hard men**, James H. Mundy presents a vivid portrait of this fascinating period in Maine history.

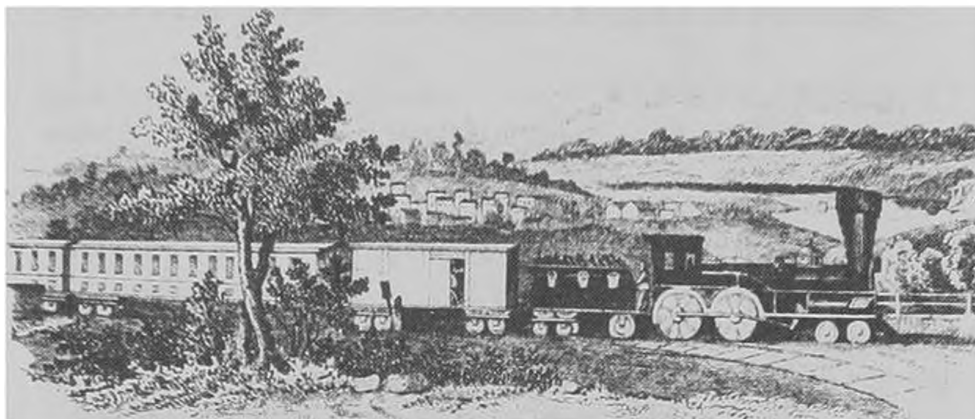
