INTRODUCTION

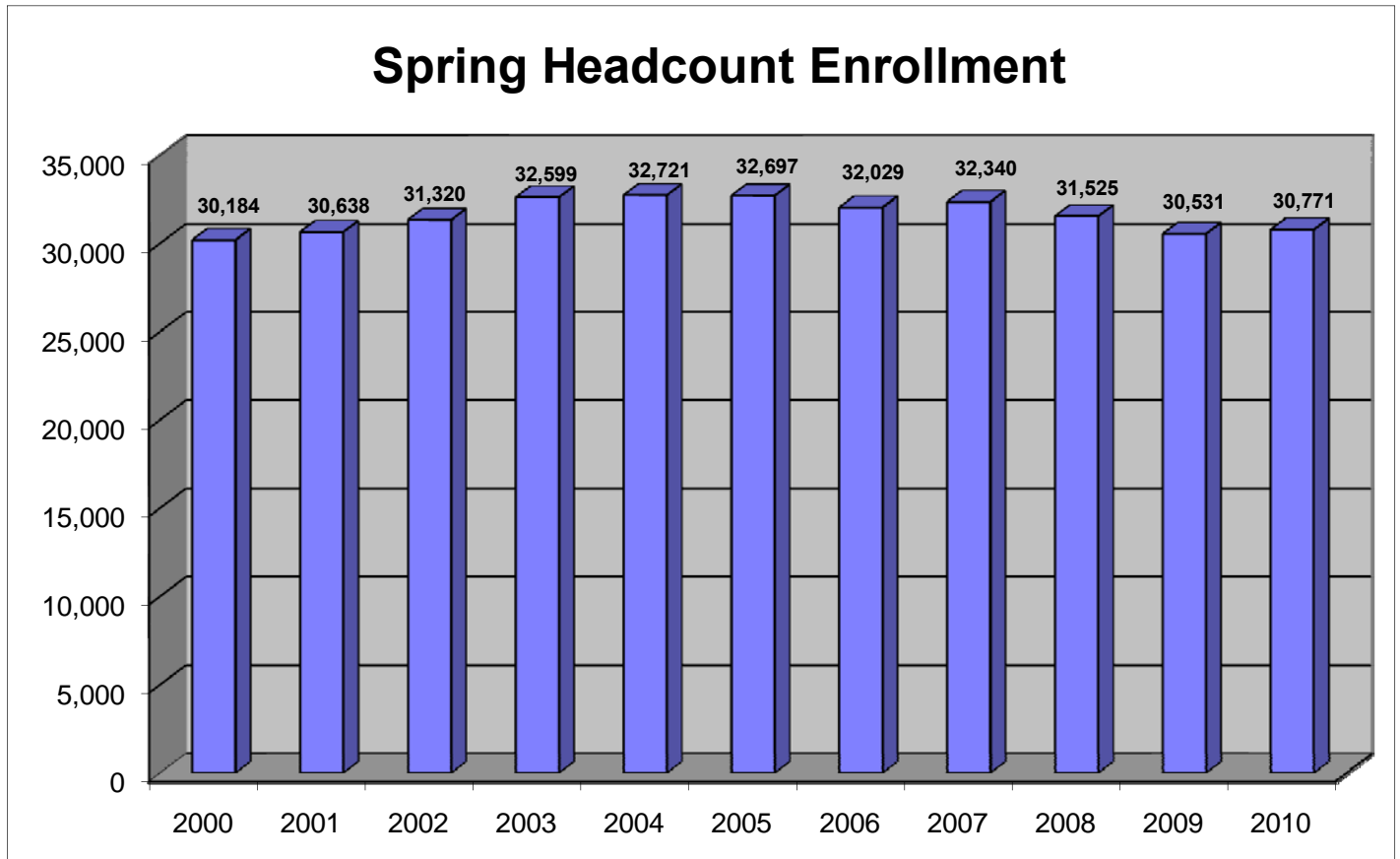
This report provides summary information regarding University enrollments. The tables and graphs show enrollments for the past 11 years, i.e., 2000-2010.

HIGHLIGHTS

- **Headcount enrollment for Spring 2010 is 30,771 students, an increase of 0.8% (240 students) from Spring 2009. Compared to last spring, the number of full-time students is up by 111 (0.6%) and the number of part-time students is up by 129 (1.1%). There are 18,439 women, up by 0.5% (86 students), who make up 60% of the student body and 12,332 men, up by 1.3% (154 students) which account for the other 40%.**
- **Spring FTE enrollment continues to remain over 22,000, with FTE enrollment at 22,305, a 0.6% increase (140 FTE students) over last spring's enrollment. For this academic year, spring FTE enrollment was 94.1% of fall FTE enrollment.**
- **Students who are Maine resident's number 27,116, 88% of total enrollment. In-state enrollment increased by 486 (1.8%) students and out-of-state enrollment decreased by 246 students (-6.3%).**
- **Non-degree students enrollment increased by 120 students (3.5%), and associate degree students increased by 111 students (6.5%), followed by graduate students with 75 (2.0%). Both baccalaureate and law students decreased, baccalaureate students by 58 (-0.3%) and law students by 8 (-3.0%)**
- **First-time, first-year students increased by 18 students from Spring 2009, an increase of 4.7%.**

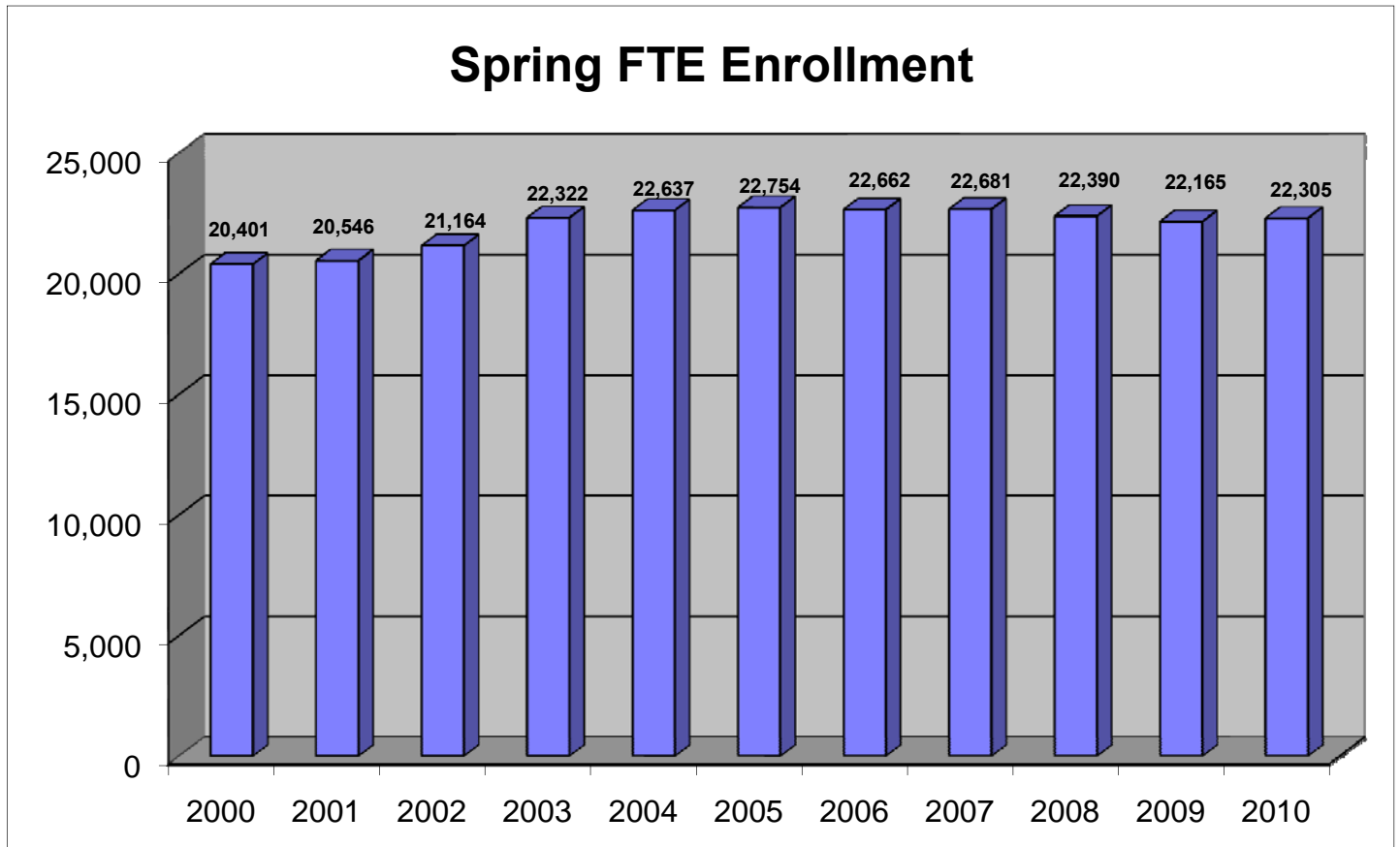

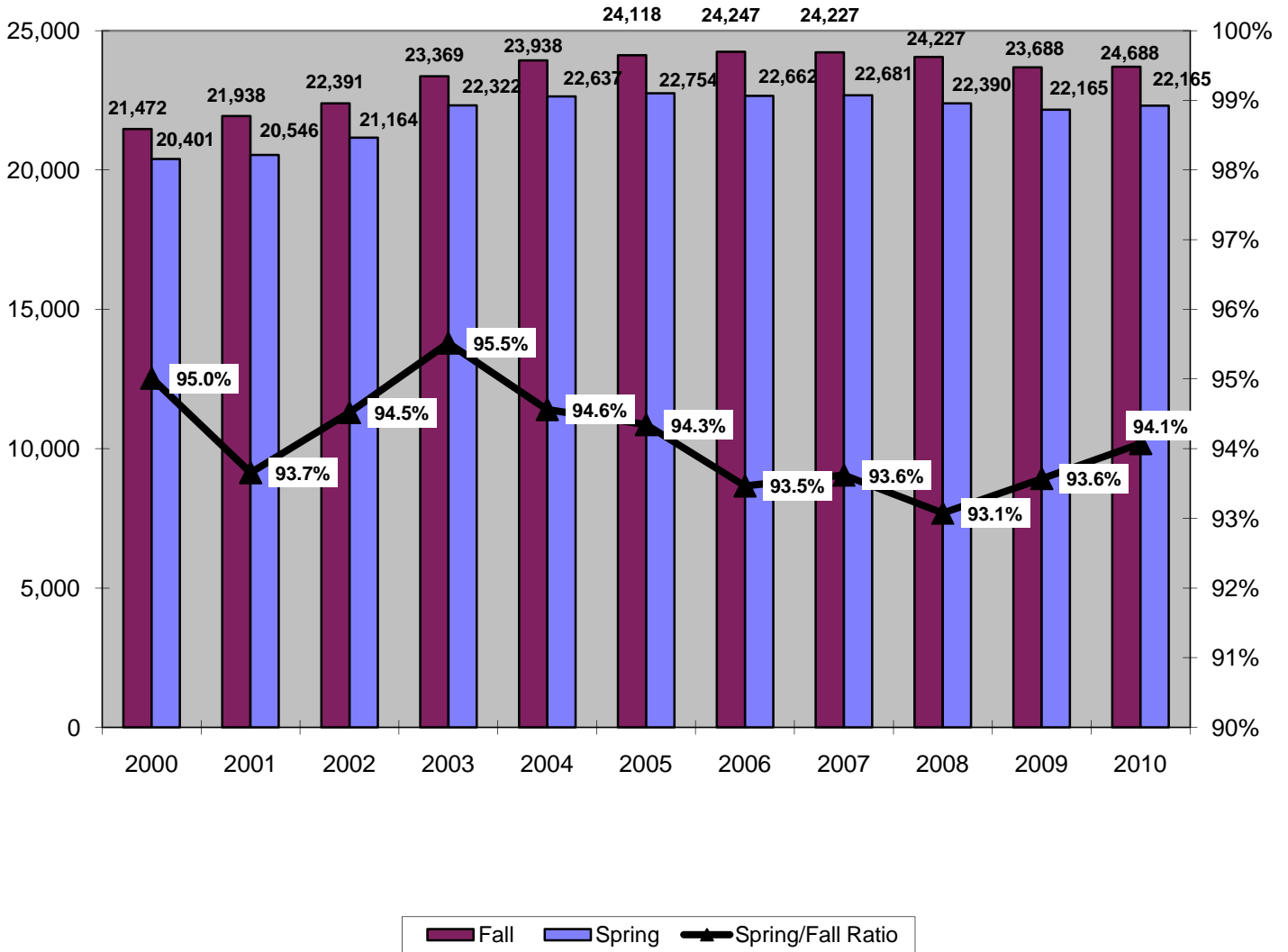

Spring In-State Enrollment



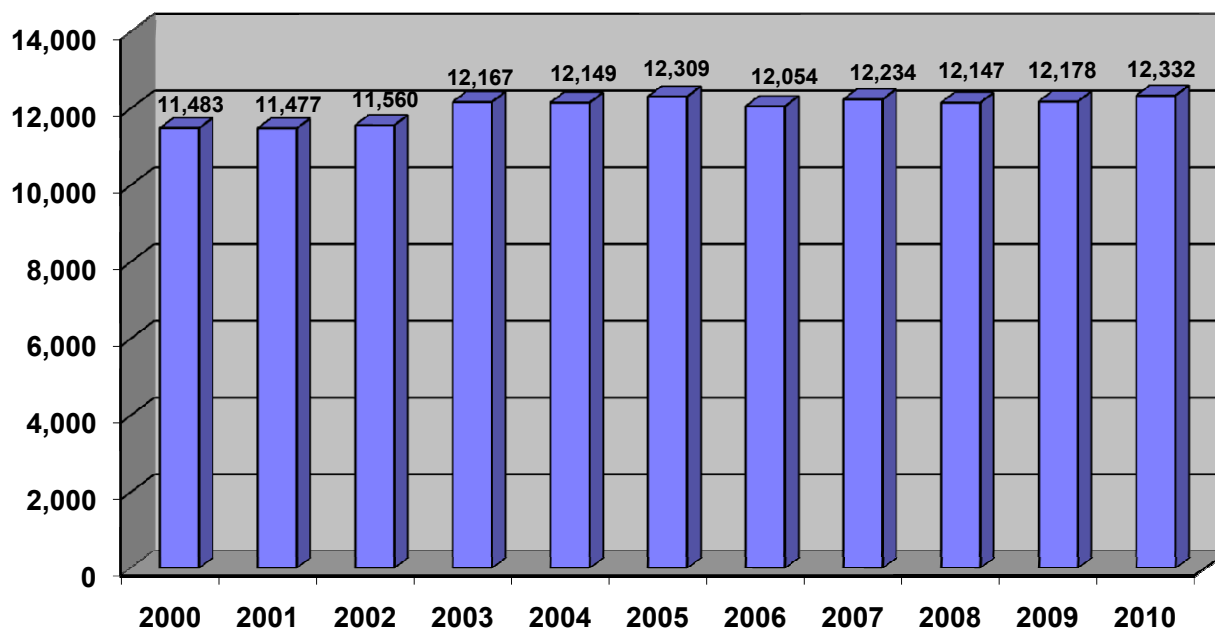
Spring Out-of-State Enrollment



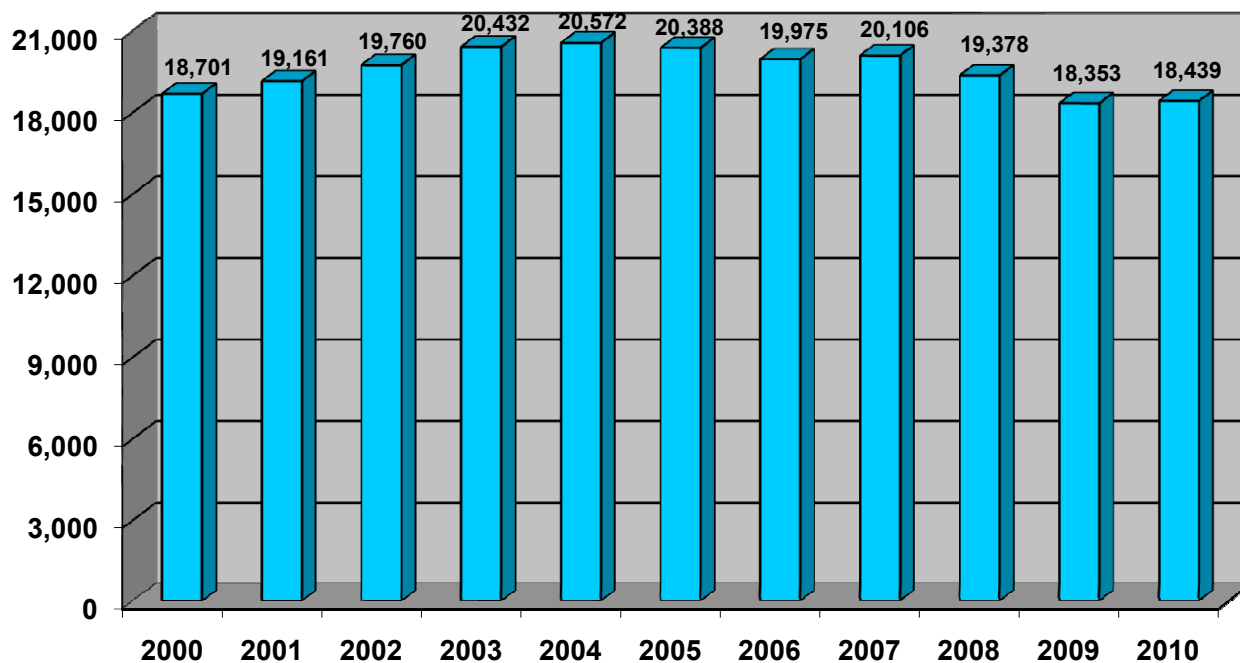

Spring Enrollment - Men



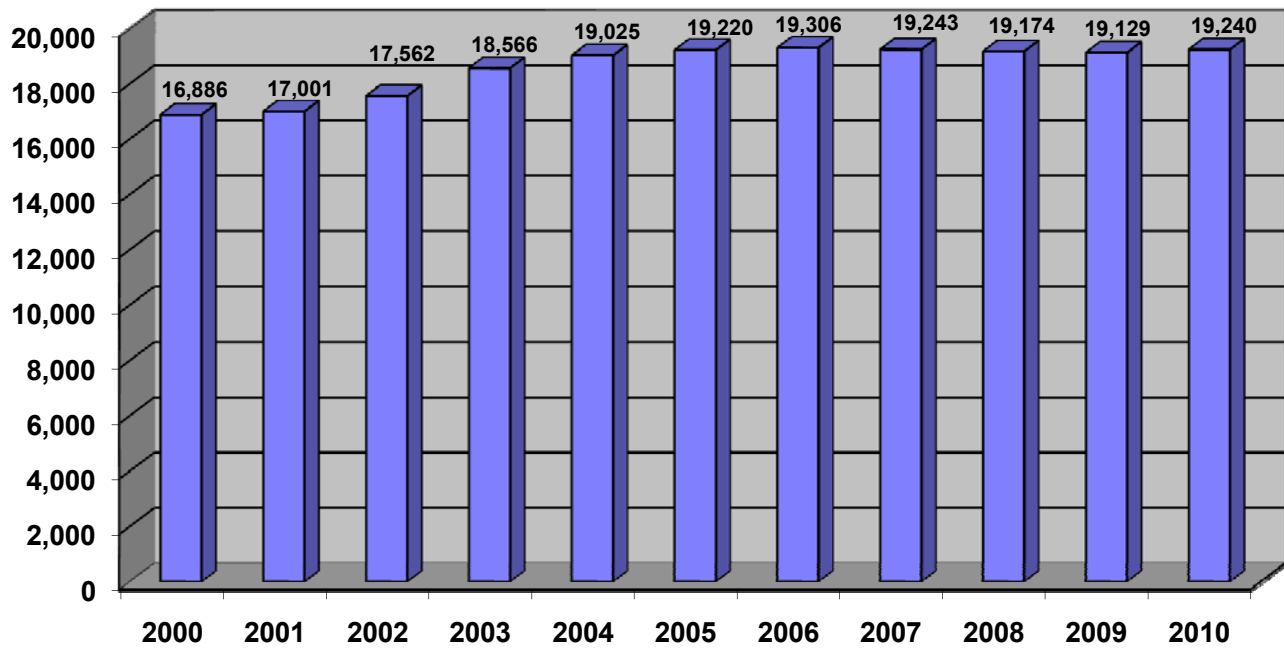
Spring Enrollment - Women



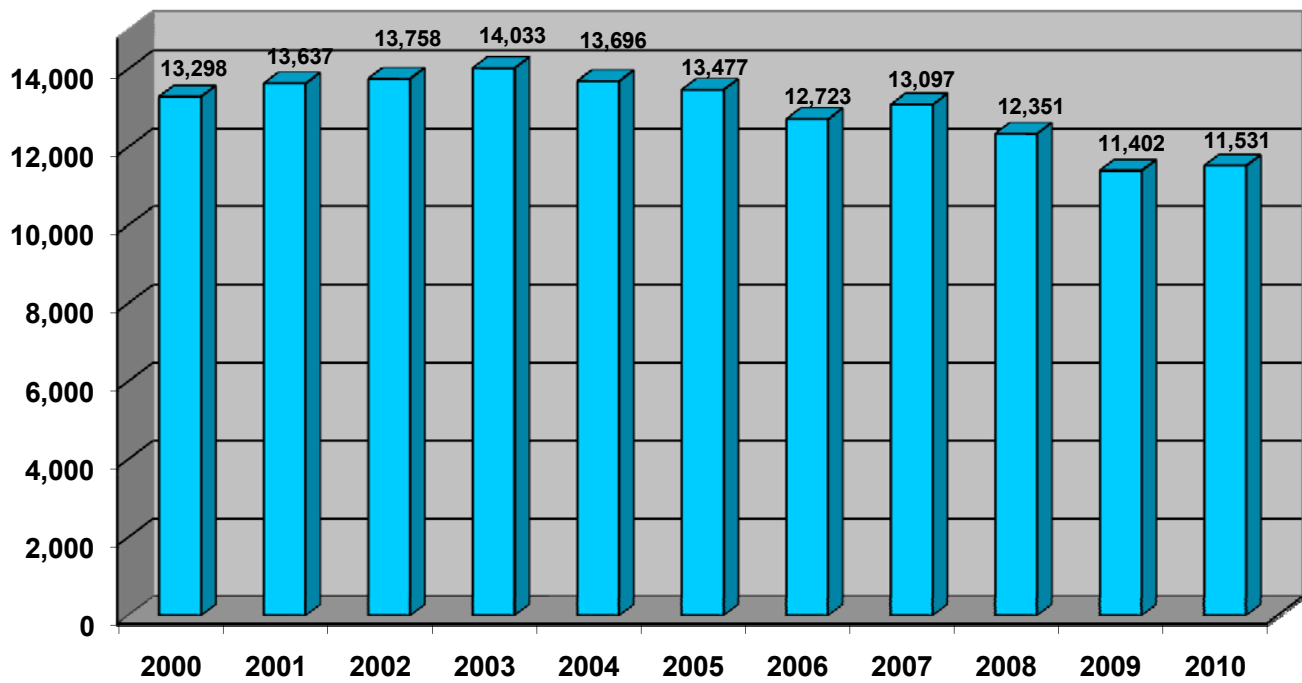
