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SUMMARY OF FALL 2010 ENROLLMENTS

HIGHLIGHTS

Headcount Enrollment

- Fall 2010 headcount enrollment for Maine's public universities was 32,009 and reflects a decline of -1.0% in total enrollment as compared to last Fall of 32,340.
- UMS enrolls approximately 65% of students currently enrolled in public postsecondary education and 45% of students in public and private postsecondary education combined.
- In-state enrollment comprises 88% of the student body. In-state enrollment decreased by -0.7% and out-of-state enrollment decreased by -3.3%.
- Women still make up the majority of students within UMS, 60%. Male enrollment decreased by -0.8% and female enrollment declined -1.2%.
- Full-time students decreased by -0.9% and part-time students declined by -1.2%.

FTE Enrollment

- At 23,535, this fall's FTE enrollment is down by -0.7% from the Fall 2009 FTE enrollment of 23,711.

Degree level Enrollment

- 69% of students are pursuing a baccalaureate degree, followed by 13% pursuing masters, certificate of advanced study, or doctoral degrees. Nearly 11% are undergraduate non-degree students and 6% are associate degree students. The final 1% of the student body is law students.

Enrollment by Age

- 67% of part-time students are between the ages of 30 and 64. 77% of full-time students are between the ages of 18 and 25.

Enrollment by Residence

- Cumberland, Penobscot, and York county residents make up nearly half of the in-state student body. The top five states represented are Massachusetts, New Hampshire, Connecticut, Vermont, and New York. Canada has 357 students enrolled followed by 52 students from China.

Incoming Student & Transfer Enrollment

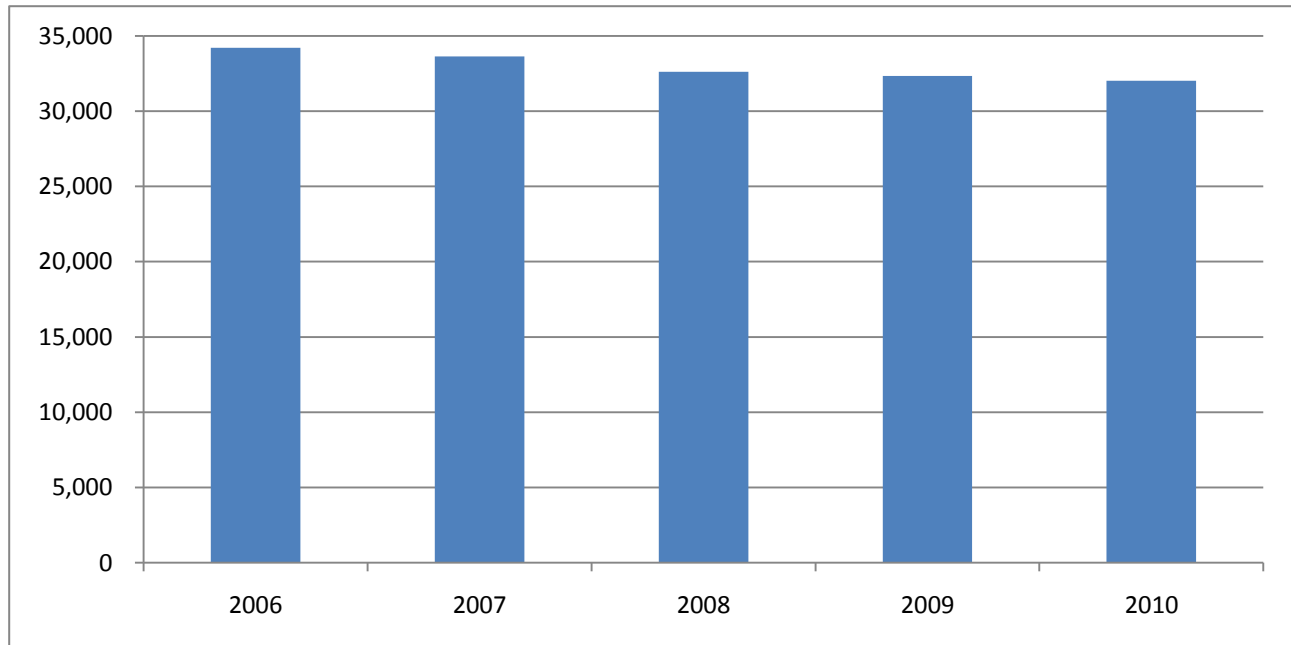
- First-time, first-year students are up by 4.4% from 4,056 in Fall 2009 to 4,236 in Fall 2010.
- Maine Community College Students grew by 12% from Fall 2009.

Distance Education Enrollment

- 15% of all credit hours are taught via distance education. Distance online credit hours make up 62% of all distance education delivery modes, followed by distance ITV at 18%, 16% by distance onsite, and 4% of distance video conferencing.

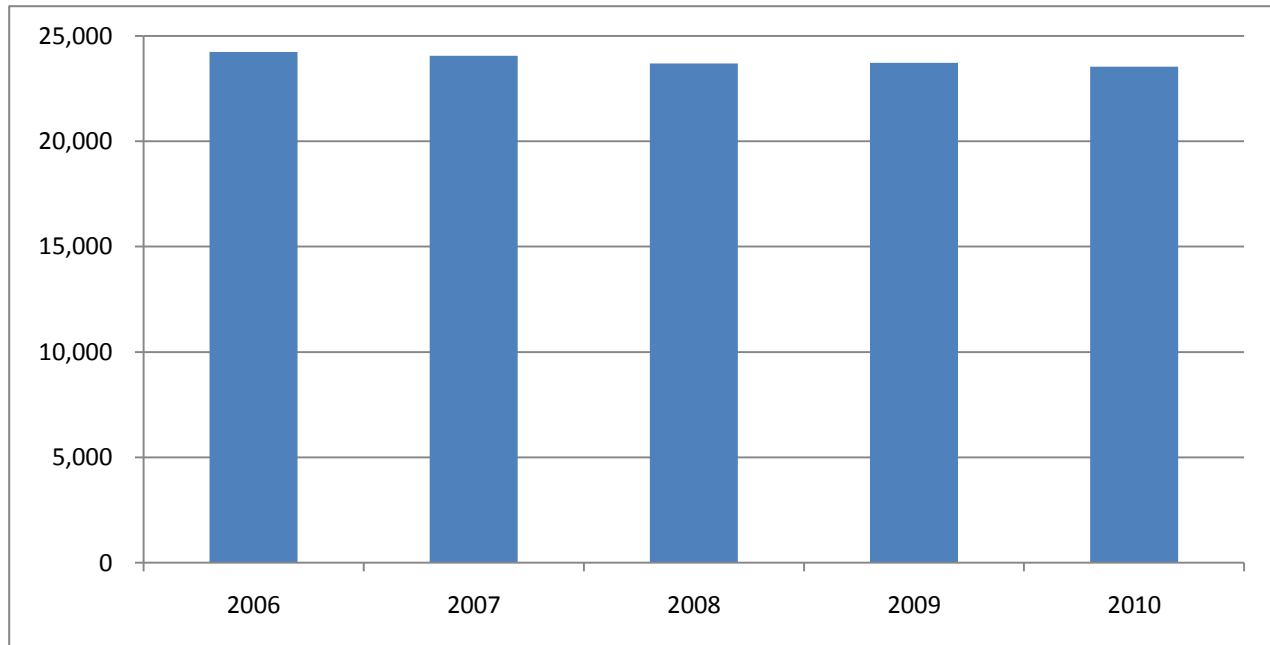

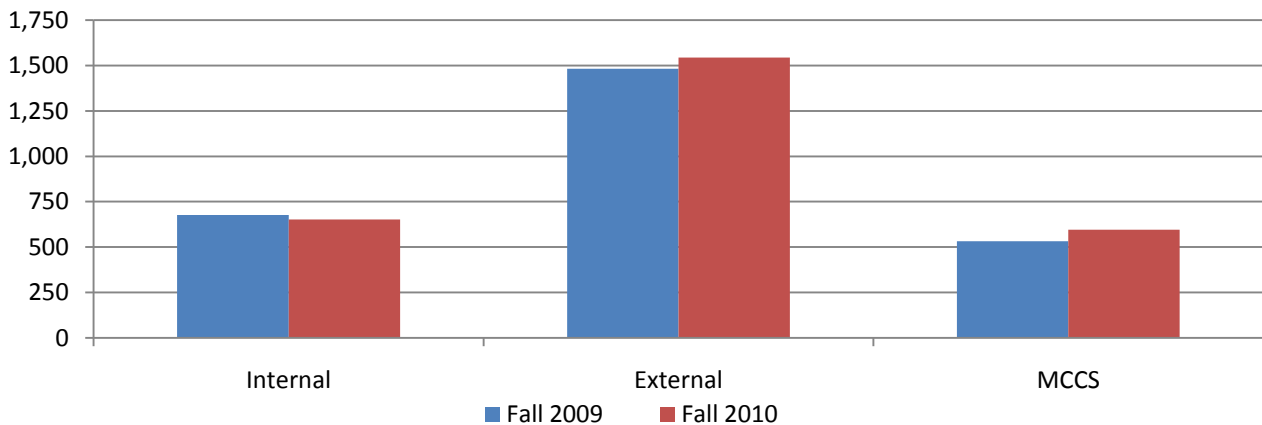

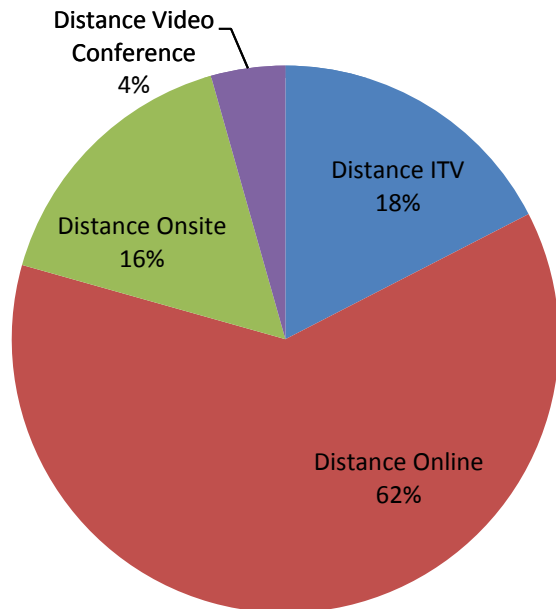
