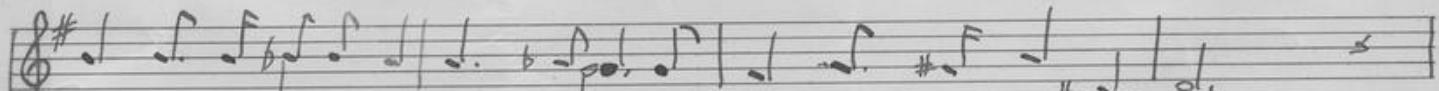
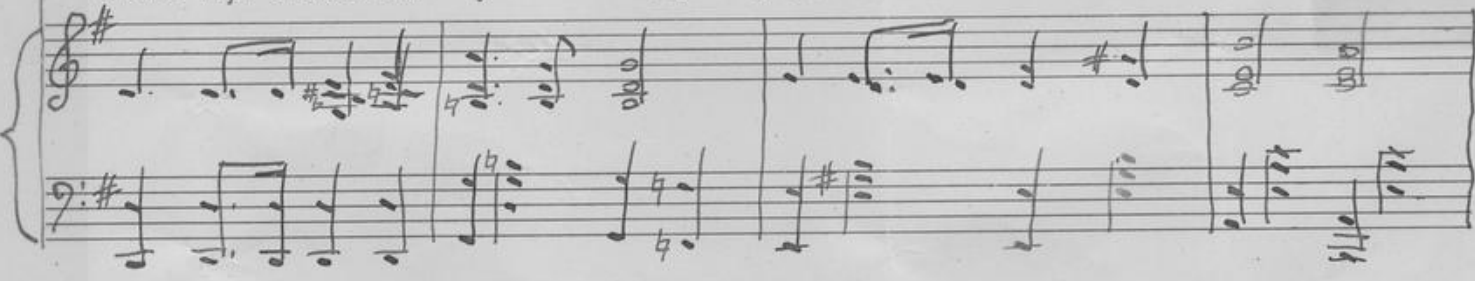
1. Land of the ver-dant roll-ing hills, Home of the spruce and pine -----  
2. We sing the praise of our home State Be-lou-ed State of Maine -----



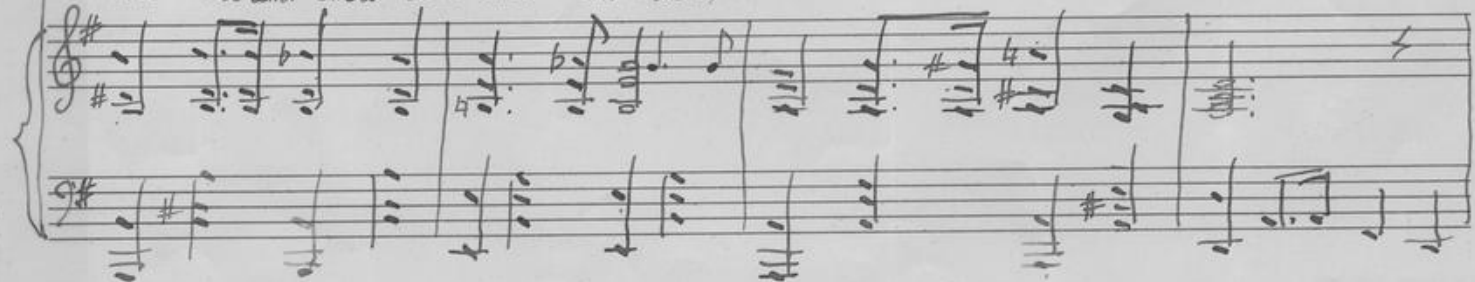
I love your brooks and gen-tle rills, They shall be ev-er mine -----
