I guess it's all right. It doesn't affect me.



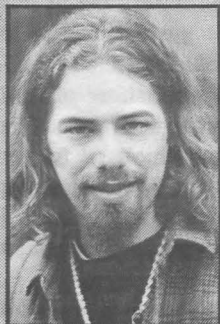
