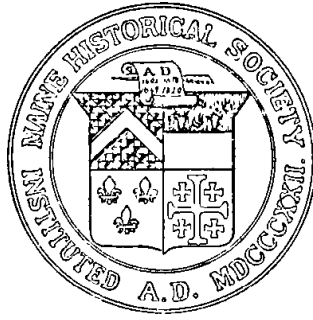

1970 DUES AND CLASSES OF MEMBERSHIP

REGULAR
MEMBERSHIP

Regular Membership for 1970 will be \$6.00. The Standing Committee reluctantly voted this increase from \$5.00 per year after they learned that in 1969 the sum of \$5.46 will have been spent on each member. This figure represents only the direct out of pocket costs of the Newsletter, notices, Annual and Special Meetings, and the Bylaws distribution and printing.

Two new classes of membership have just been created for 1970.

SUSTAINING
MEMBERSHIP

(1) *Sustaining Membership* for those who feel that they would like to make a larger contribution to the work of the Society will be \$25.00.

CORPORATE
MEMBERSHIP

(2) *Corporate Membership* for organizations and businesses will be \$50.00. This class of membership will be non-voting to aid businesses to enter the charge as a tax credit. A recent survey indicated that a number of banks and businesses would welcome a means of contribution to this Society.

LIFE
MEMBERSHIP

Life Memberships in 1970 will be \$200.00. This is an increase from \$150.00.

Members are aware of the current deficit and the growing use of our Library. This increase comes from the state as a whole particularly from the colleges. We believe we would do a great disservice to cut back. We hope contributions, this year, will help to alleviate our finances.
