Notes:

1. These tables report student credit hours (SCHs) offered by the college or academic unit, regardless of the instructor's home unit. For example, all courses having a BUA prefix are considered to be offered by the Maine Business School, even if an instructor from the College of Education & Human Development taught a BUA course. SCHs generated by multidisciplinary courses are attributed to the academic unit of the instructor teaching the course.
2. In previous years, SCHs for Honors courses were similarly attributed to the academic unit of the instructor teaching the course. In consultation with the Honors College, and to better capture Honors College instructional activity, Honors SCHs are now credited to the Honors College -- with the exception of HON 498 and HON 499, where, when possible, the home unit of the advisor will continue to be credited.
3. Courses offered via DLL include distance (e.g., online, videoconferencing, and video streaming) and CED course sections.
4. SCHs for cross-listed courses are reported in the unit of the instructor teaching the course. If the instructor's academic unit is not the unit offering the course, the SCHs are reported in the unit of the course with the highest enrollment.
