At a meeting held on Sept. 1st., 1879, the Town voted and directed the Selectmen to purchase for the use of the Town, a Steam Fire Engine. Hose &c., for same, not exceeding in cost \$3,000.00, also appropriated \$500.00 for the construction of Reservoirs, also \$200.00 for the purchase of Ladders.

At a subsequent meeting the Town voted to rescind the vote so far as related to the purchase of a Steam Fire Engine and voted and directed the Selectmen to purchase two Hand Fire Engines, Hose, &c, and we have purchased of L. Button & Sons, 1 Hand Fire Engine at a cost of \$950.00 also 1 Hose Carriage at a cost of \$140.00, paid freight on same, \$105.00. We also purchased of the American Rubber Co., 500 feet of Hose at a cost of \$375.00, also Couplings at a cost of \$3.75, paid freight on same, \$4.25, making \$1,578.00. Also expended for Reservoirs, \$346.09. Also expended for Ladders \$110.50. The balance of the above vote remains unexecuted.
