some girls do, and some girls don't, Why, you're tak-ing a chance all the time. — 'Cause time. —



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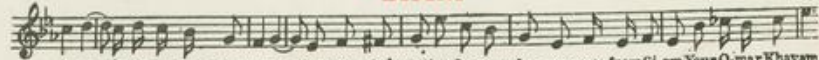
