#### REPORT OF SELECTMEN.

THE SELECTMEN of the town of Jay respectfully submit the following Report of the financial affairs of the town, from March 1st, 1875, to March 1st, 1876; also of its resources and liabilities:

The appraised value of the real and personal property liable to taxation on the first day of April, was \$526,822.00. Number of polls taxed, 294. We assessed upon each poll \$3 00, and upon each dollar of valuation 14 mills, for the following purposes:
