I have audited the accounts of the Madawaska Water Company for the year ending December 31st, 1939 and herewith submit the following schedules of operations.

All cash received has been deposited in the Bank except \$100.00 and all disbursements made by check. Cash on hand in Bank reconciles with the bank statement as of Dec. 31st, 1939.

Petty cash amounting to \$100.00 is intact in the office of the Water Dept.

Another addition to plant was made during the year costing \$10,744.27 of which \$5,510.94 was contributed by the Federal Government through WPA project No. 2655.

Gross revenues and net gain both increased for the year by approximately \$500.00 and it is also gratifying to note the excellent record of collecting Water Revenue services rendered.

Outstanding unpaid services are \$397.21 at the close of the year as against \$1,324.15 a year ago.

To Leonard Dufour, a Constable in the Town of Madawaska, in the County of Aroostook. GREETINGS:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of Madawaska, qualified by law to vote in Town affairs, to meet at the Madawaska High School Gymnasium, in said Town, on the nineteenth day of March, 1940 at nine o'clock in the forenoon to act on the following articles to wit:—

- Art. 1. To choose a Moderator to preside at said meeting.
- Art. 2. To see if the Town will vote to accept the report of the Town Officers as prepared by the Auditor.
- Art. 3. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for Town Officers' salaries.
- Art. 4. To elect under Chapter 5 of R. S. 1930, Sec. 38 to 52 inclusive the following officers for the ensuing year: Three Selectmen, Assessors and Overseers of the Poor, One Town Clerk, One Treasurer, One Member of Superintending School Committee, One Road Commissioner, One Tax Collector and One Policeman.

- Art. 6. To choose a Board of Trustees for the Madawaska Water Dept. or authorize the Selectmen to do same.

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- Art. 7. To choose all other Town Officers or authorize the Selectmen to do same.
- Art. 8. To see if the Town will vote to operate on Day-light Saving Time during the Summer months.
- Art. 9. To see what rate of discount the Town will vote to give on taxes paid before certain dates and what date the discount will end.
- Art. 10. To see what rate of interest the Town will charge on taxes and what date this interest shall begin.
- Art. 11. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for the Support of the Poor.
- Art. 12. To see if the Town will vote to raise the sum of \$40.00 for interest on Ministerial School Fund note.
- Art. 13. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for General School Account.
- Art. 14. To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for Special School Account.

- Art. 30. To see if the Town will authorize the Selectmen to borrow from time to time during the current municipal year a sum or sums of money not exceeding in the aggregate Sixty-five Thousand Dollars (\$65,000 (being an amount not in excess of the tax levy for the preceding Municipal year)

for the purpose of paying indebtedness of the Town due, or to become due during said Municipal year on temporary loans in anticipation of taxes in said current municipal year, and to execute and deliver for such loans the note or notes of the Town signed by the Selectmen and the Treasurer payable on or before March 1st, 1941, (being within the current Municipal year) out of money raised by taxes during said Municipal year. Such notes shall bear interest or be discounted at a rate not to exceed 5% per annum. All other particulars including rate, form, issuance and sale of such notes, shall be determined by the Selectmen.

- Art. 34. To see if the Town will authorize the Selectmen to buy or lease land for the purpose of building sheds to store snow fence and road machines.
