A celebration of life for Victoria A. Kane, a longtime University of Maine employee, will be held at 1 p.m. on March 3 at Buchanan Alumni House. Kane was a UMaine undergraduate student from 1979-83 and worked on campus in food service for many years, including at the Bear's Den and later as food manager at Fernald Snack Bar before transitioning to an administrative assistant position with the School of Social Work.

In 2004, Victoria participated in the first cohort of UMaine's Diversity Leadership Institute and was the UMaine Outstanding Classified Employee in 2006. On campus, she was much loved by students, staff and faculty, and was known for her friendliness and always answering the phone by saying "a gracious hello."
