On Sunday, October 20, 2024 an incident occurred in Orono where two University of Maine students were assaulted by Noah Lachapelle-Quinn. Noah is not an Orono resident or University of Maine student, but he is known to frequent student gatherings in Orono. Noah has a history of assaulting others. At this time an arrest warrant has been issued for Noah Lachapelle-Quinn for Aggravated Assault.

Noah is a white male, approximately 5'08" and weighs 225 pounds. He has brown hair and blue eyes.

The Orono Police Department is working closely with the University of Maine Police as well as local law enforcement. If you encounter Noah, please use caution and call 911 immediately.
