ANNUAL SCHOOL REPORT.

To the Citizens of the Town of Rangeley :—

In accordance with the requirements of the school laws of the State we submit the following as our annual school report, for the year ending March, 27 1893. Whole number of scholars in town 227, amount of money raised by the Town for support of schools \$550 00 amount received from State (school fund and mill tax) \$583 83.

Our schools for the past year do not show as good an attendance as the year previous, this fact we attribute to so much sickness caused by Scarlet fever and Measles.

The schools throughout the town have all done fair work. The teachers for the last year, have all had previous experience in teaching except one, and have all given as good satisfaction as could be expected.

The High school now in session is under the instruction of H. H. Randall Principal, and F. C. Luce Assistant. The school numbers over 40 scholars and promises to be a successful one.
